

UNH'S BOBBY BUTLER TABBED PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR NOVEMBER ~Merrimack's Da Costa named Top Rookie; UMass' Dainton earns Goalie honors~



<u>Hockey East Player of the Month</u> Bobby Butler – New Hampshire

Senior Forward; Marlboro, Mass.

Butler scored in all seven games in the month and posted 13 points for a 1.86 ppg average during the month. The senior forward had four multipoint efforts and two multi-goal efforts. Butler skated a +7 rating with eight goals and five assists. Butler averaged 1.14 goals per game and led the Wildcats to a 3-2-2 mark in the month. Behind Butler's efforts, New Hampshire scored three or more goals in every game this month including four games of four or more goals.

Junior Goaltender; Genelle, B.C.

Dainton posted a 3-1-0 record in four games started and took 1 loss in relief for the month of November. He posted a 2.55 GAA and a .922 save percentage in a total of 283 minutes. He allowed just one power play goal which came in his relief effort at #9 Quinnipiac. He made a career-high 42 saves in a win over New Hampshire (11/13) and 27 in a win at Vermont. In his relief effort at Quinnipiac, he made 28 saves in two periods and overtime.


