BU, NORTHEASTERN SWEEP; MERRIMACK TAKES THREE POINTS AT VERMONT ~UNH downs Providence; Eagles split with UML, win 15th Beanpot in school history~

Wakefield, Mass. - Boston University and Northeastern swept their series this weekend against Maine and Massachusetts, respectively, while Merrimack took three of four points on the road at Vermont. Boston College picked up two wins on the weekend, which included a weekend split with UMass-Lowell and its 15th Beanpot title on Monday night in the win vs. BU. League-leader New Hampshire scored three goals in the third period vs. Providence for its 13th league victory of the season.

The Terriers opened the weekend with a 7-4 shootout on Friday night vs. the Black Bears at Agganis Arena, then followed that up with a 5-2 victory on Saturday. Zach Cohen (Schaumburg, Ill.) totaled a team-high six points (2g,4a) on the week in three contests. BU owns a 8-2-0 record in league play in its last 10 games, after starting the season with a 2-7-2 mark.

Northeastern swept its first weekend league series of the season with 2-0 and 6-3 victories on the weekend. Freshman goalie Chris Rawlings (North Delta, B.C.) made 65 saves (.956 save%) against the Minutemen and he has won his last four starts for the Huskies.

Merrimack's Stephane Da Costa (Paris, France) continued his stellar freshman year with the game-tying goal on Friday (2-2) and the game-winning score and an assists on Saturday vs. the Catamounts, 3-2. Jesse Todd (Camrose, Alb.) and Da Costa scored tallies 18 seconds apart as the Warriors came from behind in the final two minutes.

Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) paced the Wildcats with a career-high four goals, which included a natural hat trick in the third period on Friday night in the 5-2 win vs. the Friars. UNH senior goalie Brian Foster (Pembroke, Mass.) stopped 28 of 30 shots against PC.

The Eagles opened the week with a 4-3 win vs. arch rival BU on Monday night at the TD Garden. UMass-Lowell humbled the Eagles with a 4-1 victory on Friday at the Tsongas Center. River Hawks' senior netminder Carter Hutton (Thunder Bay, Ont.) recorded 66 saves on the weekend vs. the Eagles. BC salvaged the final game of season series with a 2-1 triumph on Saturday night at Conte Forum. Rookie Chris Kreider (Boxford, Mass.) potted the game-winner with 14 seconds left in the game for the Eagles.

TEAM NOTES

BOSTON COLLEGE: BC's Beanpot title is its 15th overall, second in the last three years and fourth under Jerry York, who improves to 20-12 overall in the four-team tournament. BC improved to 8-12 against BU in Beanpot Championships...Junior goalie John Muse earned both the Eberly Trophy (highest save percentage) and MVP honors, stopping 64-of-67 shots (.955) in the two-game tournament to become the first BC goalie since Greg Taylor in 1994 to capture both honors...The East Falmouth, Mass., native recorded 31 saves against the Terriers to earn his 54th career win, surpassing Taylor and goalie coach Jim Logue for sole possession of sixth place on the school's win list...Junior center Brian Gibbons, whose his 11-game scoring streak come to an end in Friday's loss at UMass-Lowell, scored his 33rd goal and 99th career point in Saturday's 2-1 win over the River Hawks...BC finished 1-2-0 against UMass-Lowell, closing a league series with a fifth opponent...Freshman goalie Parker Milner (Pittsburgh, Pa.) made his first start in six games on Saturday against UMass-Lowell.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY: Following its weekend sweep of No. 12 Maine, Boston University now boasts a record over .500 for the first time this season and is 9-3-0 in 2010...The Terriers are 14-2-2 against the Black Bears since the beginning of the 2005-06 season...BU has now clinched five of its Hockey East league series, having secured them against Boston College, Maine, UMass Lowell, Massachusetts and Merrimack while only dropping one thus far (New Hampshire)...Junior defenseman Colby Cohen has totaled 16 points (9g, 7a) in his 11 games since the new year...Sophomore Ross Gaudet remarkably has scored 10 goals this season on just 30 shots...Junior Nick Bonino has 106 points (42g, 64a) in 106 career games...Senior Eric Gryba (Saskatoon, Sask.) recorded a career-high three points (1g, 2a) in Saturday's 5-2 triumph against Maine...The Terriers have scored a power-play goal in nine of their last 10 contests.

MAINE: Maine dropped a pair of games at Boston University over the weekend... It was the first time this season that Maine has been swept in a Hockey East weekend series by the same opponent... Defenseman Jeff Dimmen scored three of Maine's six goals on the weekend... He scored both Maine goals on Saturday to register the first two goal game of his career...Maine killed off 15 straight opponent power plays before seeing that streak come to an end on Friday, Feb. 12 at Boston University...The Black Bears lost for the first time this season on Friday night when scoring four or more goals...Maine had been 8-0-2 when scoring at least four goals... Maine has scored at least one power play goal in 24 of 28 games this season, including six straight...Maine's top three scorers are all sophomores in Gustav Nyquist (Malmo, Sweden) with 42 points, Brian Flynn (Lynnfield, Mass.) with 28 points and Will O'Neill (Salem, Mass.) with 24 points...A year ago, just three Black Bears hit the 20-point plateau... This season, six different Black Bears have already scored 20 points...Despite scoring just two goals at Boston University on Saturday night, Maine still ranks third in the nation, averaging 3.68 goals per game...Maine's defensemen have combined to score 18 goals and add 54 assists for 72 points this season.

MASSACHUSETTS: UMass is 1-5 in the last six games following the weekend sweep by Northeastern...Northeastern shut out UMass on Friday night – just the second shutout against the Minutemen all season...In the last six games, UMass is scoring just 1.7 goals per game on 34.3 shots, has converted 3-of-36 (8.3%) on the power play and is being outscored 17-to-4 in the first two periods of those games...Defensively in the six game stretch, UMass is allowing 4.2 goals per game and has allowed opponents to convert 8-of-34 power play chances...Prior to the past six games, UMass was averaging 3.3 goals per game and converted 24.5% (27-110) of its power play chances...UMass will face Merrimack in a home-and-home series this weekend...UMass has won 11 straight games against Merrimack at the Mullins Center...Saturday's game will be Senior Night for UMass as well as the unveiling of the UMass All-Decade Team.

UMASS-LOWELL: With the campaign winding down, the River Hawks clinched the season series with #10 BC for the second consecutive season...UMass Lowell's weekend split with the Eagles gave Blaise MacDonald at least 15 wins in a season for the sixth time as the head coach of the River Hawks...In Friday's 4-1 victory, UMass Lowell scored two power play goals and two empty net goals...Sophomore David Vallorani (Hamilton, Ont.) tallied his 50th career point, assisting on Patrick Cey's (Saskatoon, Sask.) game-winning goal...Carter Hutton stopped 34-of-35 shots to pick up his ninth victory of the season...For the weekend Scott Campbell potted

two goals, both with the man advantage...The scores gave him 11 for the season, seven of which have come on the power play...Senior winger Chris Auger assisted on three of the River Hawks' five goals on the weekend. Auger has tallied a team-high 18 of his 19 points in conference play.

MERRIMACK: Merrimack is 2-0-1 in its last three games after picking up its first road point of the season on Friday and its first road win on Saturday. They are unbeaten in three straight HEA games for the first time since 2005-06 and for just the second time under head coach Mark Dennehy...The Warriors have eight Hockey East victories for the first time under Dennehy. Until this season, they had not won eight Hockey East games since the 1996-97 season...Merrimack won the season series (2-0-1) vs. UVM for the first time since the Catamounts joined Hockey East...Stephane Da Costa, who continues to lead all rookies in scoring nationally and in Hockey East, tied the all-time Division I school record for points in a season by a rookie (35) by Casey Kesselring (1994-95) and Rob Atkinson (1990-91). No Warrior has registered 35 points since Anthony Aquino in 2001-02...Da Costa and Chris Barton both have points in six straight and eight of nine...Jesse Todd (Camrose, Alb.) netted the game-tying goal on Saturday, marking his first goal in 21 games...The Warriors won for just the second time this year when the nation's second-best power play does not score.

NEW HAMPSHIRE: Bobby Butler scored a career-high four goals including a natural hat trick in the third period to break a 2-2 tie and lift the Wildcats to a 5-2 win over Providence on Friday night. It marks the first time since Dec. 11, 2008 a UNH player recorded four goals and a natural hat trick in a game. Mike Sislo accomplished both in a 9-4 win over Holy Cross. Butler, the league's leading scorer with 35 points in HE play, is tied for the nation's lead in goals scored with 23 and ranks in the top five nationally in points, points per game, goals and goals per game...UNH remains unbeaten against Hockey East foe (7-0-2) at Whittemore Center this season. The 'Cats last Hockey East loss at Whittemore Center was Jan. 25, 2009 a 3-1 loss to BU; they are 11-0-3 since that loss in league games at the Whitt. New Hampshire retained its three-point lead over second-place Boston College thanks to a win and a BC split with UML, while it extended its lead to five points over three-place Maine with a pair of Black Bear losses at BU.

NORTHEASTERN: Northeastern won its fourth straight game and fifth consecutive Hockey East contest with the sweep of Massachusetts this weekend. The consecutive victories marks the first time Northeastern strung together two victories against a league opponent this year. The Huskies are now three games over .500 and undefeated in Hockey East play for the month of February...Northeastern is 12-1-1 when it scores first...Saturday night's win was the first time three Huskies posted two assists in a game this year. Vermeersch registered his third two-assist outing of the season while Drew Daniels recorded his first multi-point outing of the year. McNeely posted three helpers against UMass Lowell on Jan. 9...Vrolyk notched his first-career multi-point game by way of two lamplighters. Vrolyk's tear started by potting the second goal against UMass on Friday, Jan. 12. The Boylston, Mass. native is riding his first-career pointstreak heading into the Boston College game...MacLeod has notched eight points in his last four games while McNeely has logged eight in his last five. He secured his eight multi-pointer of the year and 22nd of his career.

PROVIDENCE COLLEGE: Providence College ranks 15th in the country and second in Hockey East on the penalty kill with an 84.5 percentage...The Friars have thwarted eight consecutive opponent power plays, including a two-minute, two-man advantage against No. 15 UNH on Friday...Providence has played against five consecutive ranked opponents...Senior Mark Fayne's 14 assists this season are two shy of what he had in his first three years combined at Providence...Sophomore goalie Alex Beaudry (Cumberland, Ont.), who has 727 saves this season, is 49 stops short of reaching the top 10 in PC's single season saves mark. Beaudry still ranks in the top-13 nationally with a .918 save percentage...Two of John Cavanagh's three goals this season have come against UNH...Sophomore Andy Balysky (Randolph, N.J.) recorded his first goal of the season on February 12 at UNH.

VERMONT: The Catamounts enter the week in a tie for ninth in the latest Pairwise Ratings...Vermont went 3-for-8 on the power play this past weekend against Merrimack and 6-for-6 on the penalty kill...Sophomore Rob Madore (Pittsburgh, Pa.) made a season high 42 saves in Saturday's 3-2 loss against the Warriors...Vermont is 0-0-5 in overtime this year following Friday's 2-2 tie against Merrimack...Junior Jack Downing (New Canaan, Conn.) scored two goals on the weekend and is tied for second on the team in goals with nine...Vermont visits New Hampshire for a two-game set this weekend...The Wildcats won this season's first meeting 5-2 at Gutterson Fieldhouse on Dec. 6.

Commissioner's Corner with Joe Bertagna

With the Women's Hockey East standings showing a three-way tie at the top with one weekend of regular season play remaining, it seems like a good time to go over the tie-breaking criteria used by Hockey East. As with most leagues, the directors of Hockey East put a premium on head-to-head play. So the first tie-breaker is just that. The second is league wins. And then results against the league's best, starting from the top, are compared.

Given the type of year we have experienced from the start, not only is there a strong likelihood of ties in the final standings, there could very well be a three-way or even a four-way tie at some spots. In fact, had one score been reversed in WHEA action yesterday, that three-way tie for first place would have been a four-way tie today.

When more than two schools are tied, the tie-breaker criteria are applied until a team drops from consideration. When a three-way tie is thus reduced to a two-way tie, the criteria are applied all over again from the beginning.

Starting next week, as has been our practice in recent years, we will publish the tie-breaker procedures in our release and we will calculate the various places a given school could finish. This is what makes this time of year so much fun for just about everyone...with the possible exception of the coaches!
