## BC ADVANCES TO FROZEN FOUR WITH 9-7 WIN OVER YALE IN REGIONAL FINAL ~UNH and Vermont end seasons in NCAA Tournament play~

**Wakefield, Mass.** - Boston College picked up two victories and a trip to the 2010 Frozen Four with wins over Alaska and Yale at the NCAA Northeast Regional in Worcester over the weekend. The Eagles advanced to the Frozen Four for the ninth time in the last 13 seasons on Sunday night.

In Saturday's quarterfinal, BC skated to a 3-1 victory over Alaska. Rookie Pat Mullane (Wallingford, Conn.) scored the game-winner to help the first seeded Eagles advance to the Northeast Regional Final on Sunday evening against Yale. In Sunday's, contest BC and Yale proved why their offense ranks among the top nationally, as 16 goals were scored. The Eagles led the game 6-2 midway through the second but Yale rebounded pounding in 5 more goals before the game was over. BC won by a final score of 9-7 thanks to four-point performances by Athletic Republic Player of the Week Cam Atkinson (Greenwich, B.C.) and Joe Whitney (Reading, Mass.). Atkinson's three goals marked his third hat trick in the last 10 games. Atkinson was named the Most Outstanding Player of the Northeast Regional in Worcester. In goal, John Muse (East Falmouth, Mass.) recorded 60 saves on the weekend and is now 6-0 in NCAA Tournament contests. The Eagles will face top seed Miami at Ford Field in Detroit, Mich. on Thursday, April 8th in the Frozen Four at 8:30 pm EST on ESPN2

UNH upset Cornell on Friday in the opening round in the East Regional in Albany, N.Y. at the Times Union Center. Six Wildcats registered multi-point nights including UNH leading scorer Bobby Butler (Marlboro, Mass.) and teammate Paul Thompson (Derry, N.H.) who both chipped in with two goals and an assist in the 6-2 victory over the Big Red. Brian Foster (Pembroke, N.H.) had a solid performance between the pipes registering 24 saves in the win. On Saturday, the Wildcats were edged by Rochester Institute of Technology by a score of 6-2 in the Regional Final. Butler ended his season being named to the All-Regional Team for his efforts over the weekend. Phil DeSimone (East Amherst, N.Y.) and Blake Kessel (Verona, Wis.) were the only Wildcats to score in Saturdays contest.

Vermont fell to the number one seeded Wisconsin by a score of 3-2 in the first round of the NCAA West Regional at the Xcel Energy Center on Friday in St. Paul. Wisconsin scored the first goal of the game, but the Catamounts answered with a quick goal less than two minutes later by Dan Lawson (Oak Forest, Ill.) who netted his first of the season. Senior Brian Roloff (West Seneca, N.Y.) potted another goal giving the 'Cats a 2-1 advantage heading into the second period. The Badgers came out with force and outshot Vermont 16-3 in the second period, which included two power-play goals. Vermont netminder Rob Madore (Pittsburgh, Pa.) recorded 39 saves in the loss and earned Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week honors.

**Bobby Butler, UNH (Sr., F, Marlboro, Mass.)** Was named to the All-Regional team at the NCAA East Regional in Albany. Butler led the Wildcats to a 6-2 upset win over sixth-ranked Cornell. The senior forward had a pair of goals and an assist.

**Phil DeSimone, UNH (Jr., F, East Amherst, N.Y.)** Tallied a goal on Saturday night against RIT and dished out a pair of assist in a 6-2 win over Cornell on Friday night.

**Brian Foster, UNH (Sr., G, Pembroke, N.H.)** Was solid once again for New Hampshire, stopping 51 shots in two games at the NCAA East Regional.

**Jimmy Hayes, BC (So., F, Dorchester, Mass.)** Scored twice in the third period, just 23 seconds apart, for his first multiple-goal effort of the season and the fastest pair of goals by one player in regional history.

**Dan Lawson, UVM (Jr., D, Oak Forest, Ill.)** Scored a goal and had an assist against Wisconsin in the NCAA West Regional on Friday night.

**Carl Sneep, BC (Sr., D, Nisswa, Minn.)** Scored one shorthanded goal, tallied a plus-minute rating of +4 and earned All-Tournament Team honors in victories over Alaska and Yale.

**Paul Thompson, UNH (Jr., F, Derry, N.H.)** Scored a pair of goals and handed out an assist in UNH's 6-2 win over Cornell.

**Joe Whitney, BC (Jr., F, Reading, Mass.)** Matched a career-high with four points (2g,2a) in the team's 9-7 win over Yale in the NCAA Northeast Regional final.

### CAREER FIRSTS/MILESTONES/WHO'S HOT?

#### PAT MULLANE, BC (WALLINGFORD, CONN.)

Tallied two points (1g,1a) in the NCAA Northeast Regional, extending his scoring streak to five games (1-4-5)

#### UNH WILDCATS

UNH qualified for the NCAA tournament for the ninth-consecutive season. The second-longest active streak in the country. The Wildcats finished the season with 34 consecutive successful penalty kills.



## TEAM NOTES

**BOSTON COLLEGE:** The Eagles improve to 27-10-3 this season and have won seven in a row. They have advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Frozen Four for the 22nd time in school history, including the ninth time (in the last 13 seasons) under head coach Jerry York...They are now 39-37 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. Boston College improved to 13-0-0 this season when scoring five or more goals...Cam Atkinson (Greenwich, Conn.) now has 12 multiple-point games this season, including three hat tricks. His 27 goals are fifth-best by a Boston College sophomore, one behind Craig Janney (1986-87) and Joe Mullen (1976-77), both of whom had 28...Jimmy Hayes' back-to-back third-period goals 23 seconds apart are the fastest consecutive goals scored by the same player in an NCAA regional game and the fifth fastest in NCAA Tournament history...Boston College has won five straight at the DCU Center and is 8-1 overall in NCAA Tournament games held at the arena. Junior goaltender John Muse (East Falmouth, Mass.) is 6-0 in the NCAA Tournament and 15-1 in postseason games...Boston College tied the mark for most goals scored by one team in an NCAA regional game. It had been done three previous times, the most recent being Minnesota's 9-2 win over Mercyhurst in the West Regional on March 28, 2003...BC last met Miami (Ohio) in the NCAA Tournament in the 2008 quarterfinals, which they won, 4-3, in overtime. The Eagles are 2-0 all-time against the Red Hawks in the NCAA Tournament, as they also squared off in the quarterfinals in 2007, which Boston College won, 4-0.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE:** UNH advanced to the NCAA regional finals for the second-consecutive year...The Wildcats have advanced to the NCAA's in nine-straight seasons, a mark which is second only to Michigan (20)...All four teams in the 2010 NCAA Frozen Four were on New Hampshire's schedule this season...Senior Bobby Butler was named to the 2010 NCAA East Regional All-Regional team...Butler registered a pair of goals and an assist on Friday night against Cornell. Butler ranks first in the nation in goals with 29 and is tied for second in points with 53...Butler's first goal on Friday night snapped a 267:11 shutout streak for netminder Ben Scrivens and cracked UNH's streak of 160:07 with a goal...New Hampshire improved to 3-0-0 all time against the Big Red in the NCAA's including wins in 2002's second round and in the national semifinals in 2003...Brian Foster finished second on UNH's single season saves list with 1,128. Foster also became just the ninth goaltender in program history to capture 40 wins. Others include All-Americans Kevin Regan, Mike Ayers, Ty Conklin and Cap Raeder...The New Hampshire penalty kill successfully killed off the final 34 penalties of the season with its last goal against coming on Feb. 19 against Vermont.

**VERMONT:** The Catamounts dropped to 3-6 all-time in the NCAA Tournament in their fifth ever appearance...Vermont (17-15-7) posted a sixth straight winning season for the first time in program history at the Division I level...The Catamounts are 13-4 in their last 17 non-league games and 1-3 all-time against the Badgers...Sophomore Rob Madore (Pittsburgh, Pa.) made 39 saves against Wisconsin...Madore is 2-2-0 with a 2.43 goals against average and a .924 save percentage in four NCAA Tournament games...Junior Dan Lawson (Oak Forest, Ill.) had a goal and an assist against the Badgers...Lawson's goal was his first since scoring the game winner in a 3-2 double overtime victory against Air Force in the NCAA East Regional in Bridgeport, Conn., last March...Ironically both goals went to video review and initially were ruled no goal... The Excel Energy Center, the home of the Minnesota Wild, is the sixth NHL rink that Vermont has played at in program history. The Catamounts have also played at the Boston Garden and TD Garden the home of the Boston Bruins, the Verizon Center the home of the Washington Capitals, the Hartford Civic Center the former home of the Hartford Whalers as well as the former home of the St. Louis Blues the Checkerdome...The Xcel Center is the site for the 2011 NCAA Frozen Four.

**HOCKEY EAST IN THE FROZEN FOUR:** Six Hockey East teams have won the NCAA Championship, all of which have come in the last 17 years, which includes: Maine (1993), Boston University (1995), Boston College (2001), Boston College (2008) and Boston University (2009)...Over the past 13 seasons, Hockey East has boasted 21 teams in the Frozen Four of the 52 qualifiers during that time...Hockey East teams have qualified for the Frozen Four in 17 of the last 18 seasons, including the last four years...Since 1993, Hockey East has had 17 of the 34 teams that have advanced to the Championship Game.

## Commissioner's Corner with Joe Bertagna

Hockey East celebrates its 14th Frozen Four semifinalist in the ten years beginning with 2001. Boston College claims six of those, including four times in the last five years. Pretty impressive.

What hasn't been impressive is the Hockey East Frozen Four record in Detroit, site of this year's event. The NCAA has held its biggest games in Detroit on five occasions and Hockey East has sent teams in four of them. Not counting two match-ups where Hockey East teams played each other, no Hockey East team has won in Detroit.

In 1977, BU and UNH lost in the semifinals to Michigan and Wisconsin, respectively. BU won the consolation game over the Wildcats. In 1979, UNH lost to Minnesota in the semis and Dartmouth in the consolation game.

In 1985, the first year of Hockey East, Providence outlasted BC, 4-3 in three overtimes, to advance to the final, where the Friars lost to RPI, 2-1. BC lost the consolation game to UMD. In 1987, Hockey East teams failed to advance. In 1990, Colgate and BU lost to Wisconsin and Colgate, respectively. By that time, the consolation game had been eliminated.

So, if you are keeping score at home, the Hockey East non-league record in Detroit Frozen Four play is 0-8. Time for the Eagles to turn things around.
