Regionals

• Since regional tournament play began in 1992, 31 of the 52 teams that have advanced to the Frozen Four from the eastern regional tournaments have been from Hockey East. Seventeen Hockey East teams have been sent to the western regionals in the same span, but only two of those have advanced to the Frozen Four.

Frozen Four

• Over the last 20 seasons, Hockey East has boasted 26 of the 80 Frozen Four qualifiers, the most of any conference. By comparison:

Hockey East: 26	WCHA: 19
CCHA: 15	ECAC: 8
NCHC: 8	Big Ten: 4

• At least two Hockey East teams have qualified for the Frozen Four in 13 of the conference's 34 previous seasons, dominating the competition in that span. By comparison:

Hockey East: 13 times
WCHA: Six times
CCHA: Six times
NCHC: Three times
ECACH: Two times
Big Ten: One time

Championship Game

• At least one Hockey East team has appeared in the National Championship Game in 18 of the last 28 years. Hockey East was represented by at least one team in the NCAA championship game in each of eight straight years from 1997 to 2004. That is the most consecutive appearances in the title game by any conference since the inception of Hockey East in 1984-85. Hockey East has boasted 21 of the 46 teams that have advanced to the championship game since 1993.

• On three occasions (1995, 1999, 2015) the NCAA championship game featured two Hockey East squads. The only two other occurrences of this since the inception of Hockey East in 1984-85 were once each by the WCHA (in 2005) and ECAC (in 2013).

• A Hockey East team has won the NCAA championship game in five of the last 11 seasons.
