Poulin recorded six points, including a career-high four goals on Friday Oct. 15 and a two-assist effort on Saturday. She finished the two-game sweep of Wayne State with 12 shots on goal and a +5 plus/minus rating.

### WHEA DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Molly Schaus recorded her 60th win after Saturday's 4-1 win over Vermont...Of the five new freshmen on this year's squad, three have scored goals, four have scored assists, and all five have started...Kelli Stack was named Star of the Game twice this weekend...Molly Schaus and Kristina Brown were each named stars once. Stack and Wasylk are proving to be a formidable first-line offensive duo, as they have combined on five of each other's combined nine goals...The last time BC went 4-0 to start a season was in the 2007-08 season...that season's squad saw its first loss in the fifth game, so if this year's team is poised to for a strong start. BC plays at Quinnipiac on Friday. With a BC win on Friday, it will be the first time in program history that the team has opened the season at 5-0.

**Boston University:** The Boston University women's ice hockey team is currently riding a four-game winning streak...With her third shorthanded goal of the season on Oct. 15, freshman Marie-Philip Poulin tied BU's single-season record for shorthanded tallies in just four games...Jillian Kirchner (2g,5a), juniors Jenelle Kohanchuk (3g,5a), Jenn Wakefield (7g,4a) and Carly Warren (1g,5a), and Poulin (8g,5a) have notched at least one point in each of BU's five games...With four goals against Wayne State on Oct. 15, Poulin became the first Terriers to tally four goals in a game since Kohanchuk accomplished the same feat vs. Wayne State during the 2009-10 season.

**University of Connecticut:** For the second weekend in a row a UConn player has recorded a goal and an assist in a game, with Jennifer Chaisson doing so against Colgate and Maude Blain doing so last weekend against Clarkson...Five freshmen have accounted for nine of UConn's points so far this season, including four points from Taylor Gross...With 37 saves over the weekend, Alexandra Garcia is just 10 saves shy of reaching the 1,000 save mark for her career...she would be fourth Husky to post 1,000 saves in her career...Jennifer Chaisson has posted at least one point in all but one game this season, and leads the team with five points on the year (2G, 3A)...With 46 career assists Jennifer Chaisson is five shy of taking over third place on the UConn all-time career assists chart

**University of Maine:** Maine split its weekend series with Quinnipiac...It was the Black Bears' fifth and sixth consecutive home games to start the season...The last time Maine started the season with this many home games was the 2000-01 season when they started with four home contests...At 3-3-0, it is the Black Bears' best start to a season since they were 3-2-1 to start the season in 2004-05...Brittany Dougherty (Chesterfield, Mich.) has 10 points in six games, giving her a 1.67 points per game average, tying her for 15th nationally. Dougherty has a goal in her last three games and has tallied a goal in five of Maine's first six contests. Her 10 total points ties her for seventh nationally...Maine leads the nation in power play goals with 11...Maine's power play ranks third nationally at 27.5%.

**University of New Hampshire:** Following a 9-for-9 effort at Union, UNH's penalty kill is perfect this season at 30-for-30. The team that has scored the first goal has won all five games...Nicole Gifford recorded her first career point with a goal at RPI; Maggie Hunt tallied her first collegiate point with an assist vs. the Engineers; Emma Clark recorded her first point as a UNH Wildcat with an assist at RPI. Lindsey Minton earned her first collegiate point with an assist during her 19-save effort at Union. Arielle O'Neill finished with a personal best of three points vs. Union by matching her high of two goals. Both of Kristina Lavoie's goals this season have been game-winners; last year, only one of her 18 goals was a game-winning tally.

**Northeastern University:** Northeastern scored two shorthanded goals in Saturday's 6-4 win over RMU. The last time the Huskies notched a shorthanded goal was on Oct. 31, 2009 against Vermont when Brittany Esposito scored the game's lone goal. In both games this weekend, the Huskies notched a goal at the 19:59 mark of the second period. On Saturday, freshman Maggie DiMasi tallied a power play goal, and on Sunday Alyssa Wohlfeiler notched her first goal of the season...Florence Schelling and Leah Sulyma split the weekend series, both earning wins. The last time both goalies earned a win over one weekend was Jan. 23-24, 2010 at Niagara. Jan. 23-24, 2010 was also the last time the Huskies won two straight games until this weekend.

**Providence College:** The Friars have now won five games in a row. Their longest such streak from a year ago was seven games (from 1/3 to 1/24). The team will look to match that streak this coming weekend with home games against RPI and Princeton...As a team, The Friars are averaging 4.25 goals per game, good for 5th in the nation...Before the game with RPI, the Friars will have a check presentation, making a donation to the make-a-wish foundation. The team raised the money last month with its first annual Road hockey Rumble, a street hockey tournament for the Providence College community. The fund raiser was the idea of PC junior defenseman and Torney Organizer Christie Jensen (Delta, B.C.).

**University of Vermont:** Saturday afternoon marked Seniors Peggy Wakeham (Bay Roberts, Newfoundland) and Jul Sifers (New London, Conn.) 100th career game at Vermont...Four of the five Vermont goals this season have come in the first period...Vermont is 0-0-2 on the season when they score first...Senior captain Celeste Doucet (Memramcook, N.B.) leads the Catamounts in scoring with two goals, and one assist...Vermont continues their non-conference schedule against the Yale Bulldogs next weekend with a two game set at Gutterson Fieldhouse... Last year the Catamounts were 4-6 against ECAC teams.
