TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Molly Schaus and Meagan Mangene returned to the Heights after winning silver with the U.S. team in the Four Nations Cup...Saturday's win at BU was the highest-scoring game of the season for BC, with four different goal scorers: Kelli Stack with a hat trick and Ashley Motherwell, Taylor Wasylyk, and Danielle Welch with one apiece...the six goals also featured six athletes with assists: Jessica Martino, Mary Restuccia, Dru Burns, Katelyn Kurth, Melissa Bizzari, and Danielle Welch...the Terriers were the first team they've faced with a higher ranking so far this season...BC will host Dartmouth on Wednesday, November 24.

Boston University: The Boston University women's ice hockey team split its weekend series with Boston College on Nov. 20-21...The Terriers' 1-0 shutout victory on Sunday marked BU's first whitewash since blanking New Hampshire, 4-0, in last year's Hockey East semifinals...Junior Jenn Wakefield extended her point-scoring streak to 10 games with four points (1g, 3a), including Sunday's game-winning goal, during the Terriers' two-game series with Boston College. Wakefield is now tied with freshman Marie-Philip Poulin for the team lead in goals (11)...BU will return to action for two games against Princeton on Nov. 26-27...Saturday's game against the Tigers will be held at Agganis Arena as it marks the fourth straight year the Terriers play a regular-season game at the home of the BU men's ice hockey team.

University of Connecticut: The Huskies are on a four-game win streak, defeating Maine, UNH and Vermont over the past three weeks...UConn extended its win streak over Vermont last weekend, now holding a 10-game win streak over the Catamounts in the past three seasons...The Huskies have recorded back-to-back shutouts over Vermont in the last two games...Alexandra Garcia recorded her second shutout of the season against Vermont, and her second in two weeks, as she blocked all 27 shots against the Catamounts...With her assist on the game-winning goal last weekend Kelly Horan is now tied for second on the team with seven points (3g,4a).

University of Maine: Maine was idle over the weekend after skating to a pair of ties at home against Northeastern last weekend...The Black Bears will face-off against UNH Tuesday night in a neutral site game at the Androscoggin Bank Colisee in Lewiston, Maine...Last season in Lewiston, Maine skated to a 1-1 tie with Boston University before dropping the shootout to the Terriers...Maine has enjoyed late surges this season as they are out-shooting their opponents 116-109 in the third period and outscoring the opposition 41-34 in the third period...Maine ranks in the top three in special teams play as they sit third in the league in power play offense at 19.4% and third in penalty kill 87.8%...After their contest with UNH, the Black Bears continue on the road to Pittsburgh for a pair of weekend contests at Robert Morris.

University of New Hampshire: Tuesday's game vs. Maine at Lewiston, Maine will be the fifth regular-season neutral-site game for UNH in the past decade...Lindsey Minton has started each of the last eight games; she has a 5-3-0 record with a 1.50 GAA, .929 save percentage and three shutouts in that span...Freshman forward Sarah Campbell is the only 'Cat who has more than one point in the last three games; she has one goal and one assist for two points...In Hockey East league play, Arielle O'Neill and Kristina Lavoie are the team's leading point scorers with three points apiece, whereas Campbell, Emma Clark and Bryanna Farris are tied for the team lead in plus/minus (+3).

Northeastern University: Katie MacSorley's five point game was the first by a Husky since Chelsey Jones tallied five points against Maine on Dec. 3, 2006 (3-2-5). She also had the first Husky hat trick since Julia Marty notched three goals against Maine on Nov. 9, 2008...The Huskies are now 7-0-1 when Claire Santostefano records a point...All five of Northeastern's goals on Sunday came at even strength. The last time the Huskies scored five even strength goals was January 21, 2003 against Boston College, a 5-4 win...Florence Schelling has allowed just one goal in four of her last five home starts.

Providence College: The Friars will play Brown on Friday in the annual Mayor's Cup. Before the Friar's home game on December 4th, the team will present donations to SOAR and Sojourner House, two organizations that work for the prevention of Domestic Violence and care for its victims. The Friars' Leigh and Nina Riley are the first siblings to play on the same PC women's hockey team since the Ricci sisters in 1988.

University of Vermont: Vermont is 1-0-6 when scoring the first goal this season...Senior captain Celeste Doucet (Memramcook, New N.B.) with three goals, and four assists...Vermont has gone to overtime in seven of their 13 games this season...Seven ties in a season sets a new team record...Roxanne Daville has started five consecutive games for Vermont, she has given up just nine goals on 148 shots during that span...Vermont will play three games against ECAC opponents next week...Vermont hosts Saint Lawrence Tuesday night and will play a two-game set at Clarkson next weekend...The Catamounts are 1-0-3 against ECAC teams this season.
