**#11 CORINNE BUIE, PROVIDENCE** (Freshman Forward; Edina, Minn.)

Buie had a five-point weekend (1g,4a) for the Friars. She contributed three assists in the Friars' 4-2 win over UNH on Saturday, and added an unassisted goal and an assist in PC's 5-1 victory over UConn on Sunday. She finished the weekend +4 rating for the Friars.



### WHEA DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**#27 GENEVIEVE LACASSE, PROVIDENCE** (Junior Goaltender; Scarborough, Ont.)

Lacasse collected two more wins for the Friars this weekend with 44 saves (.936 save%), bringing her total to a league-best 13. ### TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** BC heads into the December break with an 11-2-4 record, 6-1-2 in Hockey East... Kelli Stack scored her third hat trick of the year and assisted on a goal to tally 21 goals, 11 assists, and 32 points in just 17 games...Melissa Bizzari stepped up on offense with a goal and two assists...Danielle Welch had two assists...once again, BC featured a range of goal scorers (4) and athletes with assists (7)...the 6-2 win was the second time BC has scored six goals this season...it was BC's fifth all-time win against Harvard...the last time the Eagles beat the Crimson was February 10, 2009 to become Beanpot Champions...BC will break for the rest of December until a December 31 contest at Princeton, slated for a 12p.m. start.

**Boston University:** The Terriers improved to 12-2-3 (4-3-1 WHEA) with a 4-0 win vs. UConn Saturday...BU's whitewash of the Huskies was BU's second straight Hockey East road shutout... BU shutout Boston College, 1-0, on Nov. 21...Freshman Kerrin Sperry improved her undefeated record to 9-0-2 with 12 saves vs. UConn...With a game-winning goal against Connecticut, junior Jenn Wakefield ranks assists in the nation with five game-winning tallies...The Terriers successfully defended all three UConn power plays to improve its penalty kill efficiency to .951, second best in the nation.

**University of Connecticut:** UConn is now 41-30-16 all-time against Hockey East opponents... Taylor Gross has a team-high 10 goals on the season while Jennifer Chaisson leads the Huskies with nine assists...UConn has allowed just two goals on opponent power plays over the last seven contests, holding six of their last seven opponents scoreless on 17 power play chances...Four Huskies have tallied at least three assists and three goals so far this season, Gross (10G, 4A), Chaisson (3G, 9A), Kelly Horan (4G, 6A) and Sami Evelyn (3G, 5A)...Gross has now recorded at least one point in 11 games this year, including a season-high of four against Sacred Heart last month...Chaisson ranks third all-time at Connecticut with 52 career assists after her helper at Providence...Alexandra Garcia has recorded at least 30 saves in eight games this season for a season save total of 462

**University of Maine:** Maine after defeating Vermont 3-2 on Saturday night, Maine had their six-game unbeaten streak snapped when they lost to Vermont 4-3 in overtime...Junior captain Dawn Sullivan scored her second game-winner of the year when she notched the game winner with just nine seconds left in regulation on Friday at Vermont...The win was Maine's seventh of the season which is the most its had in a season since it won 10 games during the 2006-07 season...The Black Bears have scored power play goals in their last five games as Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) leads the way with five power play tallies. Sullivan has tallied a goal in three of her last four games while Brittany Dougherty currently rides a five game point streak...Kelly McDonald had an assist in both games for Maine with her first career point coming on an assist Friday night...Maine returns to action Friday night when it battles Union College at Alford Arena.

**University of New Hampshire:** With her career-high two-goal effort at 10th-ranked Providence, senior forward Julie Allen climbed into a tie for third on the team in goals (four) and a tie for fourth in points (eight); Allen ranks third on the team in shooting percentage...UNH's loss to Northeastern on Dec. 1 ended a 27-game unbeaten streak (26-0-1) vs. the Huskies...The Wildcats surrendered two power-play goals in a game for the first time this season when PC went 2-for-7 on Dec. 4...UNH scored a power-play goal vs. 10th-ranked Providence; the 'Cats had not netted a power-play goal since Oct. 23 vs. St. Lawrence. The 4-2 loss at PC ended a mark of five consecutive games in which the Wildcats did not score multiple goals in a game.

**Northeastern University:** The win on Wednesday was the first Husky victory in regulation at UNH since Jan. 21, 2001, a 2-1 win...Northeastern recorded a shutout victory over UNH for the first time ever on Wednesday...In every win except the 2-1 victory over Princeton on Oct. 22, a Husky rookie has recorded at least one point. Two Huskies, Katie MacSorley and Maggie DiMasi, tallied points in the 4-0 win over UNH...Rachel Llanes recorded her first-ever multi-goal game on Wednesday when she potted a pair of goals against UNH...Northeastern is unbeaten in six of its last seven games.

**Providence College:** The Friars have now won four games in a row. Their longest such streak from a year ago was seven games (from 1/3/10 to 1/24/10). The team is now off for the semester break, returning to action at Maine on January 2...This week, Bacon was one of 40 players invited to USA Hockey's Women's Winter Training Camp in Blaine Minn. In late December. The camp serves as a tryout and training session for the U.S. National Team. Bacon previously wore red, white and blue for the USA Under-18 team that won the World Championships in 2008...Lacasse has been selected to play for Hockey Canada's Under-22's in the MLP Cup in Switzerland in January.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont is 2-0-7 when scoring the first goal this season...Senior captain Celeste Doucet (Memramcook, N.B.) is tied for the team lead in scoring with three goals, and four assists...Sophomore Erin Wente's four-goal weekend against Maine brings her season total to five goals and two assists for seven points as well...Saturday Vermont went to overtime for the ninth time in 18 games this season...Vermont is 1-2-3 in its last six Hockey East contests...The Catamounts are off until December 29th when they host Dartmouth College at 5 p.m.
