NORTHEASTERN HEAD COACH DAVE FLINT

On general comments from today's game...

I thought it was a great hockey game. Both teams played hard for sixty minutes. We battled as hard as we could. I think we just ran out of gas down the stretch. We couldn't amount a good attack in the third. Playing fourteen and then we lose (Kristi) Kehoe there in the second, and we go down to thirteen, and you are playing at a pretty fast pace. I think we kind of ran out of gas there in the end. We didn't have much left in the tank.

On how losing Kristi Kehoe affected their line combinations...

Well you role three lines and she is on our second and third line and she is on our power play up top. Losing her, she is a very good defensive forward but she can also make things happen offensively and after we played so hard yesterday, and everybody was a little tired today. The emotion can only take you so far. When you lose a kid that is out there, I mean, she kills penalties and she is on the power play, she is playing a regular shift. You lose that kid and now somebody else has to pick up the slack, so we were doubled shifting some kids. One thing we decided was if we are going to go down, we are going to go down with our best players on the ice. We just came up a little bit short.
