TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Boston College received the four-seed – its highest ever – in the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year...BC will host No. 10 St. Lawrence on Sat. March 10 at 1 p.m.... The Eagles are 2-3 all-time in the NCAA Tournament...Freshman C Alex Carpenter and Junior D Blake Bolden were named first team Hockey East All-Stars at the league's annual banquet on Friday, March 2...Carpenter was joined by classmates Emily Field and Emily Pflazer on the All-Rookie Team...The Eagles fell to eventual champion, No.9 BU, 2-5, in the Hockey East Semifinal...BC had finished the regular season 23-8-3 (15-4-2 HE), their most wins in league play under current Head Coach Katie King Crowley...at 23-8-3 GK Corinne Boyles is one win shy of tying BC's single-season wins record of 24, set by All-American Molly Schaus in 2006 and 2011...Carpenter's 1.12 points per game (19-18-37) are fifth most in the nation by a rookie and her 37 points are fourth most ever by a freshman at the Heights...Pflazer ranks second in the league for defenseman scoring with 18 points (5g, 13a), while Bolden (7g, 10a) and Dru Burns (3g, 14a) rate third with 17 tallies... The Eagles own a 7-4-2 mark against ranked opponents this season.

Boston University: The Terriers won their second WHEA Championship in program history. It was the first-ever double overtime game in WHEA Tournament history. Both of the Terriers' titles were won in overtime, and both by 2-1 scores...Senior Jenn Wakefield tallied twice in the win and earned Tournament MVP honors...BU will play Cornell in the NCAA Quarterfinals at Ithaca, N.Y. The Terriers are 0-2 at Cornell this season, but defeated the Big Red last year in the Frozen Four...Wakefield, Marie-Philip Poulin and Isabel Menard all had points in all three WHEA Tournament games this season...BU scored four shorthanded goals during the tournament... Poulin (3g, 5a) and Menard (1g, 7a) each had eight points during the tournament, while Wakefield had seven (5g, 2a).

Northeastern University: Senior Florence Schelling becomes just the second two-time winner of the WHEA Player of the Year Award and the Army ROTC Three Stars Award, next to BC alumna Kelli Stack...Northeastern has never won the Hockey East Tournament, nor has it been to the NCAA Tournament...junior tri-captain Casey Pickett and freshman Kendall Coyne won the Best Defensive Forward Award and the WHEA Rookie of the Year Award, respectively; they're the first winners of those awards in program history...Northeastern entered the tournament as the top seed in the WHEA Tournament, having never been seeded higher than fourth...with her blanking of the Huskies in the WHEA Semifinal, Providence's Genevieve Lacasse has authored the only two shutouts against the Huskies this season.

Providence College: The Friars have now played in six of the 10 Hockey East Championship games...Senior goaltender Genevieve Lacasse (Kingston, Ontario) played over 179 tournament minutes without allowing a goal, including shutouts in the quarterfinals and semifinals...Lacasse wraps her Friar career with 64 career victories, 20 career shutouts, 3,482 career saves, and 127 career-games played, all Providence College records...Senior Ashley Cottrell (Sterling Heights, Mich.) became the 32nd player in program history to reach the 100 point milestone.

Hockey East in the NCAA Tournament: BC and BU mark 18th and 19th qualifiers into the NCAA Tournament for the league in the 10-year history of the conference. League teams own a 6-11 record all-time. The conference has placed a team in the Frozen Four in four of the last six years.
