Tie-breakers:

- 1. Head-to-Head.
- 2. Number of wins in conference play.
- 3. Best record against the first-place team(s), then the second-place team(s), then the third-place team(s), and so on.
- 4. Coin Flip.

If more than two teams finish in a tie, the same criteria will be applied to reduce the number of teams tied starting from the top, and then the process will commence again.

Two-Way Tie Breakers:

BC tied series with BU, 1-1-1

(If BC and BU get four points, teams would have same record vs. teams 3-8. Coin flip would take place Sunday night)

NU currently leads series with PC, 1-0-0

NU won season series with UNH, 2-1-0

UNH won season series vs. PC, 1-0-2

PC won season series vs. Vermont, 2-0-1

UConn tied series with Maine, 1-1-1
