Boston College's Alex Carpenter Named Warrior Hockey Player of the Month BU's Rebecca Leslie Tabbed Top Rookie; Maine's Treacy Named Best Goalie



Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Alex Carpenter – Boston College

Junior Forward; North Reading, Massachusetts

Carpenter recorded 18 points in seven games during the month of October, including seven multiple-point outings and scored at least one goal in all but one game. The North Reading, Massachusetts native is tops in the nation in points per game with 2.57 and leads Hockey East in points (18), goals (8), and assists (10). A junior returning from a year spent with the U.S. Women's Olympic Ice Hockey Team, Carpenter has helped the Eagles to a 7-0-1 start to the season and a No. 1 ranking in the NCAA.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month Rebecca Leslie – Boston University

Forward; Ottawa, Ontario

Leslie lead all Hockey East rookies in points (7) and assists (4) during October and her three goals tied for the league lead among freshmen point-getters. Currently, Leslie is averaging a point per game through the Terriers' first eight match-ups. The first-year forward scored two goals at then-top-ranked Minnesota in her second collegiate contest Oct. 4, and has only been held without a point in two tilts. Leslie has also factored on two game-winning goals and boasted a plus-7 ranking for the month.

Hockey East Goaltender of the Month Meghann Treacy – Maine

Senior; Lake Peekskill, New York

Treacy has backstopped the Black Bears to the top of the Hockey East standings in October, helping Maine to a 3-1-1 record within the league. The senior netminder has stopped 275 of 293 shots seen for a .929 save percentage over 522:46 played. Treacy also helped her team to a 4-2 victory over No. 6 Boston University with a 41-save performance and has started five of her nine games against top-ten ranked programs.
