Boston College's Alex Carpenter Claims Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Carpenter, Maine's Treacy Pick Up Second Honors of the Year; BC's Kent Tabbed Top Rookie



Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Alex Carpenter – Boston College

Junior Forward; North Reading, Massachusetts

Carpenter lead the nation in every offensive category in November, recording 21 points on nine goals and 12 assists in November, despite missing two games while playing with the U.S. National Women's Team. The North Reading, Massachusetts native registered at least a point in each game, scoring at least three points five times. A junior forward, Carpenter leads the NCAA in goals (17), assists (22) and points (39) while helping to lead the No. 1 Eagles to a 15-0-1 start.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month Kenzie Kent – Boston College

Forward; Norwell, Massachusetts

Kent claims Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month after being named runner-up for the award in October. Kent picked up a point in seven of nine games played in November, kicking in two goals and 11 assists. Her 13 points over the month were the most by a freshman point-getter. Her offensive output in November launched her to the top of Hockey East in assists per game by freshmen (0.88) and first in the league and fourth in the NCAA in points per game by rookies (1.12). She leads the league in percentage of faceoffs won (.582) and sits fourth overall in the league in assists (14) and is tied for sixth in overall points (18).

Hockey East Goaltender of the Month Meghann Treacy – Maine

Senior; Lake Peekskill, New York

Treacy turned in another stellar performance in November after claiming Hockey East Goaltender of the Month in October. Backstopping the Black Bears to second place in the league, Treacy averaged 30.2 saves in five games to earn a 3-2-0 record. Her .944 save percentage and 1.79 goals against average in November were second-best in Hockey East, allowing just nine goals on 160 shots faced. Maine picked up a point in four of Treacy's five starts and she allowed more than two goals only once.
