Boston University's Poulin Wins Warrior Hockey Player of the Month Northeastern Rookie Krizova Lauded; BC's Kent Tabbed Top Netminder



Warrior Hockey Player of the Month **Marie-Philip Poulin – Boston University** Senior Forward; Beauceville, Quebec

Poulin picked up 14 points (7g, 7a) in eight games in January, contributing directly to three of Boston University's five wins on the month. She recorded five of those 14 points against two of the top three ranked teams in the nation in No. 1 Boston College (1g, 1a) and then-No.3 Quinnipiac (1g, 2a). The Eagles and Bobcats boasted the top two scoring defenses in the NCAA during that stretch. The two-time Olympian tied for the league lead in unassisted goals (3). Poulin was also dominant in the faceoff circle, winning 60 percent of her draws.

Pro Ambitions Rookie of the Month **Denisa Krizova - Northeastern** Forward; Horni Cerekev, Czech Republic

Krizova collected eight points over six games in the month of January for the Huskies. The rookie forward turned in nearly half of her production against the top-ranked team in the country in a two-game series with No. 1 Boston College, registering three points (1g, 2a). She posted three multi-point games, including a two-goal outing to help lift Northeastern, 5-2, over Maine Jan. 24. Krizova wrapped up the month with two assists at Vermont and set up the game-winning goal as her squad downed the Catamounts, 4-3.

Hockey East Goaltender of the Month **Katie Burt - Boston College** Freshman; Lynn, Massachusetts

Burt claims her second consecutive monthly honor after pitching back-to-back shutouts against Vermont to open January with the No. 1 Eagles after backstopping Team USA to a gold medal at the IIHF Women's Under-18 World Championship. Her two blank sheets tied the Boston College single-season shutout record (6) and she allowed just 1.00 goal per game while playing nearly every second of the Eagles' contests. Burt owns the second-best goals against average in the NCAA (1.03) and third-best save percentage (.945).
