NOTHING SETTLED AS TOP TWO SPLIT Connecticut sweeps over Quinnipiac and Brown

Any doubt about who was Hockey East's No. 1 team, Providence or UNH, was only further complicated with this weekend's exciting split between the two. It was their first-ever meeting as Hockey East rivals, and each entered the weekend undefeated in league play. They exit the weekend with one loss each.

The Friars got the first leg up with a solid 3-0 win at home on Saturday. Player of the Week Ashley Payton scored two of PC's three goals to lead the Friar offense. Rookie Jana Bugden outdueled heralded junior counterpart Jen Huggon, stopping all 20 shots she faced for her fifth shutout of the season. Huggon leads the nation with 11 shutouts, seven in league play. She had allowed only two goals in nine Hockey East games before Providence solved her for three on Saturday.

Huggon got a measure of revenge Sunday, however, limiting PC to a single goal on 27 shots for a 4-1 win. A victory for each of Hockey East's top two teams secured reservations for both at the first-ever Women's Hockey East championship tournament in March.

The other two spots remain up for grabs in the closing weeks. UConn has confidence on its side coming off a pair of wins against Quinnipiac and Brown. Sophomore Kim Berry had two goals and two assists over the two games and Rookie of the Week Jill VanDam scored the first three goals of her career. Meanwhile, Maine got a taste of the highs and lows of the game with two overtime contests (a win and a loss) against Cornell.

USA Hockey announced the finalists for the Patty Kazmaier Award, and two Hockey East players were among the elite 10. NU netminder Chanda Gunn got the nod for keeping the Huskies in the hunt with a .927 save percentage. Providence defenseman Kelli Halcisak was also picked as a finalist.
