### NOTHING SETTLED AS TOP TWO SPLIT *Connecticut sweeps over Quinnipiac and Brown*

Any doubt about who was Hockey East's No. 1 team, Providence or UNH, was only further complicated with this weekend's exciting split between the two. It was their first-ever meeting as Hockey East rivals, and each entered the weekend undefeated in league play. They exit the weekend with one loss each.

The Friars got the first leg up with a solid 3-0 win at home on Saturday. Player of the Week Ashley Payton scored two of PC's three goals to lead the Friar offense. Rookie Jana Bugden outdueled heralded junior counterpart Jen Huggon, stopping all 20 shots she faced for her fifth shutout of the season. Huggon leads the nation with 11 shutouts, seven in league play. She had allowed only two goals in nine Hockey East games before Providence solved her for three on Saturday.

Huggon got a measure of revenge Sunday, however, limiting PC to a single goal on 27 shots for a 4-1 win. A victory for each of Hockey East's top two teams secured reservations for both at the first-ever Women's Hockey East championship tournament in March.

The other two spots remain up for grabs in the closing weeks. UConn has confidence on its side coming off a pair of wins against Quinnipiac and Brown. Sophomore Kim Berry had two goals and two assists over the two games and Rookie of the Week Jill VanDam scored the first three goals of her career. Meanwhile, Maine got a taste of the highs and lows of the game with two overtime contests (a win and a loss) against Cornell.

USA Hockey announced the finalists for the Patty Kazmaier Award, and two Hockey East players were among the elite 10. NU netminder Chanda Gunn got the nod for keeping the Huskies in the hunt with a .927 save percentage. Providence defenseman Kelli Halcisak was also picked as a finalist.

**Boston College:** Both of BC's offensive stars managed one goal against top-ranked Harvard. Jaclyn Kryzak scored her ninth of the year and Alaina Clark notched her team-leading 12th ... Rookie defenseman Jill McInnis has six assists in the last five games.

**University of Connecticut:** The Huskies are now a perfect 6-0 against the Quinnipiac Bobcats, having outscored them 21-4 ... The win against Brown evened the series at 1-1.

**University of Maine:** Maine had two overtime games in the same weekend for the second time this season ... With five wins this season, Dawn Froats is Maine's all-time leader in career wins (25) ... Senior Raffi Wolf is tops all-time on the list of Maine scorers with 86 points, but juniors Meagan Aarts and Karen Droog are right behind her with 85 points each.

**University of New Hampshire:** The program recorded its 500th victory Sunday against Providence, lifting its all-time record to 500-131-37 (.776) ... The Wildcats are 17-0-1 when scoring the game's first goal but only 4-5-1 when the opponent scores first.

**Northeastern University:** NU faces Hockey East rival BC in Tuesday's Beanpot semifinal, which is also a league game. NU is 53-1-2 against Boston College all-time ... Chanda Gunn broke the record for saves in a period with 20 in the first period of NU's 2-0 loss to Providence on Jan. 25. The previous record was 18 set by 2001 All-American Erika Silva ...
