**NO. 4 DARTMOUTH FALLS TO FRIARS**  
**Huggon perfect again in downing Northeastern, 1-0**

Hockey East's first win over a top five opponent came on the road as Providence recorded an impressive 5-2 victory at Dartmouth, the No. 4 team in the nation, avenging an early season loss to the Big Green. Rookie goaltender Jana Bugden was solid once again, making 22 saves on 24 shots faced. Junior defenseman Kelli Halcisak set up two Friar scores, and PC took advantage of 10 power play opportunities, notching two power play goals.

New Hampshire mainstay Jen Huggon stayed just ahead of Bugden in overall play and matched Bugden's Hockey East numbers with a 1-0 win at Northeastern Thursday in the first-ever meeting between UNH and NU in Hockey East play. It was her third 1-0 victory of the season and 17th shutout of her career. Huggon and Bugden now have identical Hockey East stats (3-0-0, 0.33 GAA, .981 SP), having each allowed just one goal in three games played. Rookie Vicki Davis provided the only offense needed for UNH at Northeastern, as the Huskies suffered their sixth loss, five of which have come by a mere one-goal margin.

After going 9-3 in non-conference play last weekend, Hockey East teams continued their winning ways this past weekend with a 4-0 clean sweep. UConn survived 3-2 at Niagara Friday and Northeastern dominated Quinnipiac, 6-1, as Kim Greene scored a hat trick. BC rookie Alison Quandt put in her second straight strong performance, stopping 29 of 30 shots as the Eagles won at Yale, 3-1.

**University of New Hampshire:** Jen Huggon recorded her 17th career shutout Thursday at Northeastern to become the school's all-time leader in that category ... Seven of the past nine matches between NU and UNH have been decided by one goal. One of the other two games ended in a tie and the other ended in a two-goal differential... None of UNH's 19 skaters have a minus rating in the plus-minus statistic ... UNH's third line of Lindsay Hansen, Vicki Davis and Chandy Kaip has scored five of the team's last eight goals.

**Northeastern University:** Fraternal twins Chrissy and Kathryn Sands each recorded her first career assist in a 6-1 win over Quinnipiac Saturday. It marked the highest output of the season for the Husky offense. The Husky defense has surrendered only three goals in the last three games ... NU killed 19 straight penalties before allowing Quinnipiac a power play goal with 4:56 left.
