*Providence duo recognized for eight-game win streak*

Many players put up many points in the month of February, but it was Carolyn Gordon's goal-scoring consistency that made her the top selection as TPS Player of the Month.

A model of consistency leading a 6-1-1 month, Gordon netted at least one goal in all but one game. She sealed a strong February with a dramatic overtime goal vs. Providence. The goal capped a three-goal comeback and a weekend sweep for UNH and clinched the Hockey East regular season title for the Wildcats over the defending champs.

The 2002-03 All-Rookie team goaltender has had a relatively quiet sophomore season, but posted a great start to February. She allowed just two goals on 38 shots vs. UNH to record a 5-2 win vs. the Wildcats, and subsequently registered a sweep against Connecticut and an overtime win vs. Brown, allowing just four goals in that four-game span. She posted the league's best GAA (2.32) and save percentage (.920) in February.
