SEASON NO. 2 UNDERWAY FOR WOMEN'S LEAGUE UConn opens its season with a win and a tie at North Dakota

Three Providence goaltenders combined on the shutout. Two goalies did the trick for UNH, combining to stop all 11 shots faced as the 'Cats cruised, 5-0. Carolyn Gordon struck twice and Hockey East Rookie of the Year Lindsay Hansen had three assists.

At Boston College, both Lisa Davis and Alison Quandt had a piece of a 2-0 shutout win over the Connecticut Polar Bears. Jessica Tychsen and Lindsey Bazzone provided the offense for the Eagles with one goal each. Lindsay Snider was the only scorer for Northeastern in a 3-1 loss to the Bluewater Hawks.

The season upshifts starting this coming weekend when four Hockey East teams take on ranked opponents. Maine hosts No. 6 Wisconsin, Northeastern and fifthranked Providence travel to face No. 7 St. Lawrence, and UConn hosts No. 10 Mercyhurst for two games.
