Boston College sniper Deb Spillane is picking up right where she left off following an All-Star freshman season. She is averaging one assist per game and nearly one goal per game as the Eagles remain undefeated through their first five games of 2005-06. A true competitor, Spillane immediately went to work in the first-ever varsity meeting between heated rivals BC and BU, picking up two goals and assisting on the other in a 3-3 tie.
