### BOSTON COLLEGE ADVANCES TO FROZEN FOUR *Eagles Top Dartmouth, 3-2, in Double Overtime* *Successful UNH Run Stopped By St. Lawrence, 6-2*

Meghan Fardelmann's second goal of the game, at 4:20 of the second overtime period, lifted Boston College to a 3-2 NCAA quarterfinal victory over ECACHL champ Dartmouth on Saturday afternoon in Hanover, NH. Fardelmann, a sophomore forward from Lansing, KS, stunned the partisan crowd of 2,344 when she banged home a loose puck past fallen Big Green netminder Carli Clemis. With one shot, Fardelmann extended both the BC and Hockey East seasons, and gave the Eagles their first win over Dartmouth in 20 attempts (1-18-1).

Boston College, Women's Hockey East regular season runner-up, will advance to the NCAA Women's Ice Hockey Frozen Four next Friday night in Lake Placid, NY. The Eagles take on three-time NCAA champion Minnesota-Duluth at 8:00 p.m.

Not so fortunate was WHEA regular season and tournament champion New Hampshire, one of three seeded teams to lose at home in the NCAA Quarterfinals. (The other, #1 seed Wisconsin, survived in four overtimes, 1-0 vs. Harvard.) Despite a two-goal effort from sophomore Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, NY), the Wildcats were eliminated by ECACHL runner-up St. Lawrence, 6-2, before a crowd of 1,215 at the Whittemore Center. UNH

ends a terrific season with a record of 28-4-5.

The Boston College-Dartmouth contest was an intriguing game from the start. Dartmouth, fresh off a 7-3 dismantling of St. Lawrence in last week's ECACHL title game, came into Saturday's game with a record of 27-4-2, having started the season with two losses (at Mercyhurst). The Big Green line-up boasts four Olympians, one of whom, Gillian Apps, missed Saturday's game due to a concussion suffered last week.

Dartmouth took the play to Boston College but the Eagles rode the goaltending of Molly Schaus (Natick, MA) — who had 45 saves — and the inspired play of young forwards Fardelmann, Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, OH), and Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, MN).

After Fardelmann's opening tally at 1:11 of the first, Dartmouth controlled much of the play. But a shorthanded highlight-reel goal by Thunstrom, from Stack, at 16:31 of the second gave BC hope.

Dartmouth tied the game in the third period with two power play goals (Dartmouth had 10 PPs to four for BC), setting up the overtime. While the host Green outshot BC in the first OT by 15-4, BC had the edge in the second OT, 4-3, the one shot making all the difference.
