WOMEN'S ALL-ACADEMIC TEAM HONORS 80 Maine boasts three Top Scholars with a perfect 4.0 GPA

The Women's Hockey East Association is pleased to announce the selection of 80 student-athletes to the 2006-07 All-Academic Team. To qualify for the team, an individual must achieve a grade-point-average of at least 3.0 in each of the two academic periods during which she was actively competing.

The University of Vermont (14) had the most honorees, followed by 12 from Maine, and 11 each from New Hampshire and Boston College. Maine also had two Distinguished Scholars, Sonia Corriveau (Rouyn-Noranda, QC) and Bridgette Laflamme (St. Augustin, QC), both having earned a 3.0 or better in each semester over four varsity seasons.

The Top Scholar-Athlete Award (highest GPA for the season) is shared by three Maine teammates, Lundy Day (Calgary, AB), Pam Patterson (Miramichi, NB) and Karine Senecal (Montreal, QC), each of whom registered a perfect 4.0 this past season. They are joined on the 2006-07 Academic All-Star team by teammates Corriveau and Abby Barton (Woodstock, NB), and Kristin Norris (Bloomfield Hills, MI) of Vermont. The Academic All-Star Team identifies the top GPAs by position.
