UCONN AND UNH TAKE TWO LEAGUE WINS ~BC splits; BU, UVM play No. 9 Dartmouth tough~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The New Hampshire Wildcats and Connecticut Huskies remained undefeated in league play after taking two games from their opponents over the weekend, while Vermont took Dartmouth to overtime and the Terriers skated to a 5-5 tie with the Big Green on Sunday.

The No. 4 ranked Wildcats began the week on Thursday night with a 4-1 win against No. 7 ranked Boston College at Conte Forum and then defeated Maine, 5-0, on Sunday afternoon at the Whittemore Center. The Wildcats offensive attack was led by junior Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) and freshman Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) who recorded four points apiece on the weekend.

Meanwhile, UConn took out Providence, 5-0, on Thursday night at Freitas Ice Forum in Storrs, Conn. and then played a tight game with Northeastern on Saturday at Matthews Arena in Boston. TPS Hockey Player of the Week Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.) won the award for the third consecutive week this season posting five points (3g, 2a) to led the way for UConn. She currently ranks first in the league in scoring with 16 points in eight games, while her 2.00 points per game ranks third best in the nation among Division I players.

Nikki Petrich (Flint, Mich.) has been a key contributor for Laura Schuler's Northeastern team and she ranks second in Hockey East with six goals and her eight points is tied for third best in the conference. Petrich has scored a point in five of six games this season for Northeastern.

Sophomore goaltender Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) helped keep BU in the game on Sunday with a school record 50 saves against Dartmouth. BU's Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) and Gina Kearns (Norwood, Pa.) led the way with four and three points, respectively. The Terriers are still looking for their first win of the season, but have faced a tough opening schedule with five of their first six opponents being nationally ranked.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) recorded her 1,000th career save in the win over Maine Saturday night. She is the sixth Eagle to surpass the 1,000 mark...The Eagles scored their first short-handed goal of the season in the 3-2 win over Maine. They led the league last season with seven...11 of the 20 Eagles who have played this season have scored at least one point...Sophomore Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) and junior Maggie Taverna (Littleton, Colo.) lead the team with six points each.

Boston University: Melissa Haber's (Toronto, Ont.) 50 saves on Sunday set a new team record, surpassing junior Allyse Wilcox's (Grand Blanc, Mich.) former record of 46 saves...The Terriers twice dropped two goal leads during the 5-5 overtime tie against Dartmouth on Sunday...Boston University earned four power-play goals on nine opportunities; the team has scored nine power-play goals this season in 34 chances...The past four teams that BU has faced have been nationally ranked: seventh-ranked Minnesota, second-ranked Mercyhurst, third-ranked New Hampshire, and ninth ranked Dartmouth.

University of Connecticut: UConn is currently on a program best seven game win streak. The Huskies are currently ranked No. 8, which marks a program best in both the USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Women's poll.

University of Maine: Sophomore Forward Taryn Peacock (Calgary, Alberta) had a goal and an assist in Maine's 3-2 loss to Boston College...All of Peacock's points this season have come against Hockey East opponents and she is tied for fifth in the league in points...Genevieve Turgeon made 44 saves in the loss to New Hampshire... Freshman Jennie Gallo recorded her first collegiate point with an assist against Boston College... Maine has had one of the tougher schedules this October facing nationally ranked opponents in five out of eight games.

University of New Hampshire: UNH scored three first-period goals in both games (vs. BC, Maine) last week...The line of Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.)-Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.)-Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) combined for seven points (3g, 4a) in UNH's 4-1 win at BC and four points (2g, 2a) in the 5-0 win against Maine...After starting the season 0-for-23 on the power play, the Wildcats went 3-for-8 last week with the extra skater...Leah Craig matched her career high of three assists Sunday vs. Maine...Sophomore goaltender Lucy Schoedel (Ithaca, N.Y.) has three shutouts in seven career starts...UNH's penalty kill is perfect in the last four games at 13-for-13...UNH has surrendered a total of two goals in the last four games.

Northeastern University: The Huskies now have five players with multi-point games...Nine of the team's 17 goals have come in the third period...They have also outshot their opponents in the 3rd period 68-48...Senior captain Nikki Petrich (Flint, Mich.) has a five-game point streak (6-2-8) and leads NU with six goals and is tied for the team lead in pts (8) with her last three games being multi-point efforts.

Providence College: The Friars continue on the road this week when they travel to Boston College on Tuesday, October 30...The game will mark PC's fifth consecutive road game, marking their longest stretch of away games to open a season since the 1990-91 campaign...It will also be PC's longest stretch away from Schneider Arena this season...Each of PC's seven goals this season has been scored by a different player... In PC's game versus UConn on October 25, senior forward Jenna Keilch (Clinton Township, Mich.) appeared in her 100th career game as a Friar.

University of Vermont: Vermont saw its upset bid at ninth-ranked Dartmouth fall short Friday in a 4-3 overtime loss...Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) kept the Catamounts alive against the defending ECAC Champions with a season-high 41 saves including 17 in the third period...Chelsea Furlani had a goal and an assist in the overtime defeat...Karen Sentoff (Liverpool, N.Y.) scored a short-handed goal against the Big Green, Vermont's fourth of the season. The Catamounts had only one short-handed goal in the previous two seasons...UVM opens Hockey East play this weekend facing another two nationally-ranked foes hosting seventh-ranked BC Friday at 4:00pm and No. 3 UNH on Saturday at 7:00pm.
