## **TERRIERS EARN FIRST LEAGUE VICTORY; MAINE/UVM SKATE TO TIE** **~No. 1 UNH sweeps Niagara; Providence wins two~**

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – Boston University earned its first league win of the season on Tuesday night in a 3-2 victory at Maine, while Vermont and the Black Bears skated to a 0-0 tie on Sunday at Gutterson Fieldhouse in Burlington in the only two league games of the week. No. 1 New Hampshire swept Niagara and Providence College took two wins vs. Brown and Robert Morris.

The Terriers got the game-winning goal from Erin Seman (Ramsey, Minn.) with seven minutes left to pick up two points in the league standings on Tuesday night. BU outshot Maine, 40-13 for the game, while Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) made 37 saves in the losing effort for the Black Bears. On Sunday afternoon, Vermont and Maine skated to a 0-0 tie at Gutterson Fieldhouse. It marks the first scoreless tie in the league's six-year history. Turgeon made 23 saves, while UVM goalie Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) stopped 21 shots in the tie.

The Wildcats top-ranked offense scored 17 goals in a weekend sweep on Niagara with a 6-2 win on Saturday and a 11-1 win on Sunday at the Whittemore Center. Hockey East Rookie of the Week Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) posted five points, while Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.), the league leader in points scored, added four points in two wins for the Wildcats.

Providence defeated Brown, 5-2, in the 13th annual Mayor's Cup on Saturday and on Sunday the Friars downed Robert Morris, 7-1, at Schneider Arena. Senior forward Cherie Hendrickson (Boxford, Mass.) scored a team-high five points (2g,3a) on the week in the Friars' two victories. Hendrickson totaled a career-high four points on Sunday vs. Robert Morris.

Northeastern earned its second win of the year on Tuesday with a 3-2 victory vs. Quinnipiac at Matthews Arena. TPS Hockey Player of the Week Nikki Petrich (Flint, Mich.) scored the game-winner with 47 seconds left in regulation to give the Huskies the win, while freshman netminder Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T) had 22 saves in the win over the Bobcats.

Boston College tied Yale, 2-2, on Saturday afternoon at Ingalls Rink in New Haven, Conn. Sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) had 28 saves for the Eagles.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** BC remained undefeated in non-conference matchups (3-0-2)... The Eagles did not allow their opponent to score on a power play for the third time this season...BC has tied both Ivy League teams it has faced this season 2-2...Sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) registered 28 saves in the 2-2 tie against Yale, which gave her a career total 1,125 saves, ranking her sixth on BC's all-time save list.

**Boston University:** Tuesday's 3-2 victory over Maine was the Terriers' first conference win of the season... Boston University has played only three games against conference opponents thus far this season, but will face only Hockey East competition during the second half of the season, excluding the Beanpot...Lauren Cherewyk's (Fr., F, St. Albert, Alberta) assist against Maine Tuesday earned her sole possession of third place in the conference for assists by a rookie (5).

**University of Connecticut:** UConn had the week off after a 1-0 week of play the week before. With the win over Maine on Nov. 16, the Huskies improved to 11-2 overall. With her seventh victory this season, junior Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) moves to third in the UConn record books for wins in a single-season. Her 17 wins from last season, keep her at the top spot in that category...Wilson's 27 wins in her career puts her second among All-Time UConn goaltenders in wins in a Husky uniform...The Huskies will face Hockey East opponent Boston College in two league games this week. The battle starts on Thursday as the Huskies host the Eagles at 7:00 p.m. in the Mark E. Freitas Ice Forum.

**University of Maine:** The University of Maine (1-12-2) women's ice hockey team fell to BU Tuesday at home by a score of 3-2 but came back Saturday to tie Vermont 0-0 in Burlington...Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) and Taryn Peacock (Calgary, Alb.) scored in Tuesday's game for the Black Bears making it four straight games where Peacock had recorded a point but her streak ended Saturday in the scoreless draw...Maine remains undefeated against Vermont with an all time record of 3-0-1...The last time Maine shutout a team was against Vermont last season on Jan. 20 winning the game 3-0.

**University of New Hampshire:** All 12 UNH forwards – and three defensemen – recorded at least one point in Sunday's 11-1 win vs. Niagara...UNH's 11 goals was the team's highest total since also recording an 11-1 victory Feb. 11, 2006 (vs. Northeastern)... The six-goal second period marked the team's highest single-stanza total since March 5, 2005, when the 'Cats netted six third-period goals (vs. Boston College)...Saturday's game marked the only time this season that UNH surrendered multiple first-period goals. In the other 14 games, the 'Cats have yielded a total of three first-period goals.

**Northeastern University:** Nikki Petrich's (Flint, Mich.) three-point game was the second for the Huskies this season, as Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) had a 1-2-3 line in her collegiate debut at Minnesota on Oct. 5...Both Husky wins have come in Tuesday night games and in games in which they score the first goal...Northeastern is 2-1-0 in one-goal games this season and has not lost when leading after the second period...Four Huskies have already met or surpassed their point totals from last season.

**Providence College:** Brittany Simpson (Barrie, Ont.) has a four game point scoring streak, the longest such streak of her career...In those four games she has tallied two goals and three assists for five points...The Friars' seven goals versus Robert Morris University marked their highest single game output for the season...The last time the Friars scored seven or more goals was February 4, 2007 against Vermont, when PC was able to put ten goals on the board...In PC's game versus Brown on November 24, sophomore Jackie Duncan (Hudson, Que.) won 12 face-offs while only losing four...Her 12 wins was a season high for any Friar, as was her winning percentage...Amber Yung (Rockville, Va.) and Kelli Doolin (Dorchester, Mass.) each scored their first goals of the season versus RMU; 13 Friars have now scored at least one goal on the season...Over her last five games, junior goalie Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.) has stopped 124 of the 134 shots she has faced, a .925 save percentage.

**University of Vermont:** The Catamounts picked up their first Hockey East point of the season skating to a scoreless tie with Maine Saturday at Gutterson Fieldhouse... Kristen Olychuck (So., G, Kelowna, B.C.) made 21 saves in recording her second shutout of the season and her first against a Hockey East foe... Saturday's shutout of Maine was Vermont's second in league play since joining Hockey East in 2005-06. UVM blanked Northeastern, 1-0, on Nov. 12, 2005... The Catamounts this weekend are at Northeastern Saturday at 7:00pm and face off against Boston University Sunday at 3:00pm at Walter Brown Arena.
