UNH'S FABER WINS TPS HOCKEY PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR NOVEMBER ~Maine's Turgeon earns Top Goalie Honors; Herman wins Top Rookie Award~



TPS Hockey Player of the Month

Sam Faber – New Hampshire Junior Forward; Mt. Sinai, N.Y.

Faber posted a league-high 14 points (6g,8a) in the month of November in nine games to lead UNH to a No. 1 national ranking. She netted three game-winning goals and she owned a +10 plus/minus rating. She recorded a point in six of the nine games with four multiple point games. She tied a career-high with five points against nationally ranked UConn on Nov. 10 at the Whittemore Center. Two of her three game-winners came in league play against No. 10 BC and Vermont.

ITECH Goaltender of the Month

Genevieve Turgeon – Maine Junior Goaltender; Lac Beauport, Quebec

Turgeon posted a 2.39 GAA and a .933 save percentage with one shutout in five starts in the month for the Black Bears, including two starts against nationally ranked teams. She totaled 92 saves averaging 33.4 save per game. Turgeon was named Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week on two ocassions; Nov. 5 and Nov. 26. She had 30+ saves in two of the games, which included a 49-save performance on Nov. 2 vs. Clarkson. Turgeon registered 23 saves in the 0-0 tie with Vermont on Nov. 24, in the first scoreless tie in league history.

Rookie of the Month

Kayley Herman – New Hampshire Freshman Goaltender; Weyburn, Sask.

Herman went 7-1-0 with a .933 save percentage, 1.04 GAA and one shutout in nine November games (eight starts) and was named Mission Rookie of the Week on Nov. 19. In four Hockey East league games, she compiled a 4-0-0 record with a 1.00 GAA and .911 save percentage. In four games against nationally-ranked teams – including two against then-No. 1 Wisconsin – Herman was 4-0-0 with a 1.25 GAA and .924 save percentage. November's highlight included a weekend sweep of Wisconsin in which she stopped 41 of 43 shots for a .953 save percentage and 1.01 GAA against an offense ranked third in the nation.
