NO. 1 WILDCATS STAY PERFECT IN LEAGUE PLAY ~BC takes three points from UConn; Friars sweep Maine~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The No. 1 ranked University of New Hampshire Wildcats won two more league games over the weekend, while No. 10 Boston College took three points from No. 9 Connecticut in a battle between two nationally ranked opponents. Providence College swept Maine at Schneider Arena to create a three-way tie for second place in the league standings.

The Wildcats, who own the second longest unbeaten streak at six games (6-0-0), will be ranked No. 1 for the third straight week with a 3-2 overtime win vs. Boston University Saturday and a 4-0 shut out of Northeastern at Matthews Arena. Junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) posted three points (1g,2a) on the weekend, including her 50th collegiate goal on Sunday vs. the Huskies. Freshman Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) continued her dominance for the Wildcats in net with a career-high 24 saves in her third career shutout on Sunday.

Boston College took advantage of the big weekend series with UConn and came out with three points, after a 2-2 tie on Thursday in Storrs and a convincing 6-3 victory at Conte Forum on Saturday. Sophomore forward Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) earned five points (3g,2a) on the week to pace the Eagles, which included the game-tying goal with only 36 seconds left in regulation on Thursday. Sophomore Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Que.) had two points for the Huskies in the 2-2 on Thursday at Freitas Ice Forum.

Freshman forward Alyse Ruff (Tualatin, Ore.) paced the Friars in the 7-2 win over the Black Bears on Saturday and senior blueliner Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) had two goals in the 4-0 shutout on Sunday for the Friars.

Junior goaltender Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) had a stellar weekend with 62 saves for the Terriers in two games. She totaled 21 saves in the shutout of Vermont on Sunday and registered 41 stops on Saturday in the loss to No. 1 UNH.

Northeastern picked up its second league win of the season on Saturday with a 2-1 victory at Matthews Arena. The Huskies received strong play from freshman goalie Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.), who totaled 63 saves on the weekend, including a career-high 43 saves in Sunday's game vs. the top-ranked Wildcats.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: With Gabrielle Beaudry's (Cortland, N.Y.) assist on Saturday, 16 of the 20 Eagles who have played this season have scored at least one point. Six Eagles have recorded multiple-points games...Deb Spillane (Franklin, Mass.) leads the team with five ...The Eagles have improved their power play conversion rate from .125 (3-24) in the first six games to .250 (7-28) in the last six games. They have also improved their kill percentage from 77.8% (21-27) in the first six games to 86.7% (26-30) in the last six games.

Boston University: Allyse Wilcox's shutout Sunday was the first of the season for a Terrier goaltender, although the team earned one collectively Nov. 3 against Union...Boston University has won two of its last three games against Hockey East competition, which bodes well for the team, as it plays nearly all of its games against conference opponents in the second half of the season...With junior Sophie Thornton (St. Paul, Minn.) and sophomore Jenn Arms's (Chapin, S.C.) assists this weekend, 19 skaters have notched points for the Terriers this season.

University of Connecticut: UConn picked up its first tie of the season with the 2-2 overtime tie against Boston College on Thursday, Nov. 29...The Huskies picked up just its third loss of the season, each loss coming from a ranked opponent...Boston College was the first opponent to defeat the Huskies who was ranked below the UConn program... Junior Kristen Russell (Dauphin, Man.) recorded her first point of the season with a goal in 6-3 loss to Boston College...Senior Liz Gallinaro (Amherst, Mass.) picked up her fifth assist of the season for UConn in 2-2 overtime tie against Boston College on Thursday.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (1-14-2) women's ice hockey team fell to Providence twice over the weekend by scores of 7-2 and 4-0...Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) kept up her scoring trend as she tallied a goal in Saturday's game... It was her second goal in three games before Sunday's game...Abby Barton (Woodstock, N.B.) recorded her first goal of the season in Saturday's game as well...Next weekend Maine travels to Canton, N.Y. to face nationally ranked St. Lawrence University for a two game set. The games will mark the eighth and ninth games Maine has played against a nationally ranked team this season.

University of New Hampshire: UNH played its first overtime game of the season and defeated BU on Dec. 1...The Wildcats played seven OT games last season and are 3-0-6 in their last nine games decided by overtime...UNH has scored more goals in the third period (28) than it has surrendered overall (20); the 'Cats have also scored 20 goals in the first period...Sam Faber leads the team in goals, game-winning goals, assists, points, shooting percentage and plus/minus.

Northeastern University: The Huskies are 2-1 in their last three games...Their 4-0 loss to New Hampshire marks only the second time this season they've been shut out, and the first time they've allowed more than 40 shots in a game...Goalie Leah Sulyma's 43 saves against New Hampshire is the highest Husky save total since Sarah Bellevue's 44-save performance on Nov. 17, 2006 against New Hampshire...The Huskies were perfect on the penalty kill this weekend, not allowing a powerplay goal in six opportunities.

Providence College: Providence has won four straight games, their longest winning streak of the season. Over that four game span, the Friars have scored on eight of their 21 power-play chances (38.1%)...The Friars scored seven goals against Robert Morris University on November 25, then in their next game out against Maine on December 1, they put up seven goals again, marking the first time since the 2002-2003 season that the Friars put up seven or more goals in back-to-back games...Freshman Alyse Ruff notched the first Friar hat-trick of the season versus Maine on December 1. Before Ruff, Sarah Feldman (Fall River, Mass.) was the last to score three goals for PC (versus Vermont on January 6, 2007)...On the weekend, PC's freshmen trio of Jean O'Neill (Strafford, Pa.), Ruff, and Amber Yung (Rockville, Va.) each notched three points.

University of Vermont: The Catamounts closed out the first semester dropping a pair of tight road games at Northeastern and Boston U. this weekend...Despite only one point in league play to start the campaign, Vermont has shown improvement in both ends compared to previous years. UVM has already exceeded its victory total over each of the past two years (4 in 14 games compared to 3 in all of 2005-06 and 2006-07).
