TERRIERS WIN IN OT VS. NO. 9 BC; NU SHUTS DOWN EAGLES

~No. 1 UNH splits at No. 6 Mercyhurst~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Boston University and Northeastern both evened its record to 3-3-0 in league play with wins over No. 9 Boston College on Thursday and Saturday night respectively in the only two league games of the week. The No. 1 ranked New Hampshire Wildcats split a two-game set with Mercyhurst over the weekend in Erie, Pa.

The Terriers earned their third league win of the season on Thursday night at Walter Brown Arena, 3-2 in overtime, marking the program's second win vs. BC in school history. Sophomore forward Jonnie Bloemers (Brooklyn Center, Minn.) gave the Terriers the game-winning tally with 2:17 left in the extra frame for their sixth overall win of the year. The Terriers also defeated Sacred Heart on Saturday, scoring a season-high 11 goals in the win over the Pioneers. BU outshot Sacred Heart, 56 to 16, for the game with a 24-5 shot advantage in the third period. Eight different Terriers got into the scoring, including Erin Seman (Ramsey, Minn.), who had three points (2g, 1a) and a team-high nine shots on goal. BU has won four of its last five games.

Northeastern followed suit on Saturday at Matthews Arena and defeated the Eagles, 3-1. Freshman goalie Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) continued her strong play for the Huskies, making 32 saves in her 12th start of the season. Junior forward Missy Elumba (Cottage Grove, Minn.) tallied the game-winner for NU with her first goal of the season.

The No. 1 New Hampshire Wildcats lost to the host Lakers on Friday, 4-3, snapping their six-game win streak. The Wildcats rebounded with a 5-2 victory on Saturday to earn the weekend split. Senior forward Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) managed four points on the weekend (3g, 1a), including three points in Saturday's win for the Wildcats. Freshman goalie Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) stopped a career-high 26 saves in the win Saturday. Junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) extended her point streak to seven games over the weekend.

In other non-league contests around the league, Providence was defeated by Yale, 2-1, on Thursday and the Friars lost to No. 2 Harvard, 4-1, on Saturday. Maine also gave No. 4 St. Lawrence all they could handle on Friday in a 2-0 loss. Freshman goalie Sarah Bishop (Agawam, Mass.) made a career-high 52 saves in the losing cause for the Black Bears. No. 10 Connecticut also battled the second-ranked Crimson tough, but lost 2-0. UConn sophomore netminder Jennie Bellonio (Guilford, Conn.) did all she could to keep the Huskies in the game, as she totaled a career-high 40 saves in the loss.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: For the first time this season, the Eagles have lost two games in a row...Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) had scored at least one point in nine straight games before being silenced against Northeastern Saturday afternoon...The Eagles have come alive in the second period this season, outscoring opponents, 17-9...BC owns a 5-0-0 when leading after two periods.

Boston University: Boston University set records for goals scored (11), combined goals in a game (12), scoring advantage (10) and shots (56) against Sacred Heart on Saturday...Jillian Kirchner also set a record against Sacred Heart with her four assists...Erin Seman has scored two goals in each of the Terriers' three contests against Sacred Heart.

University of Connecticut: UConn lost its second straight game of the season and picked up its fourth loss to a ranked opponent...With the 2-0 loss to Harvard, it marked the first time all season that the Huskies were shutout of a game. The Huskies were outshot 42-14 in the 2-0 loss to the Crimson, the largest deficit of shots on goal all season.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (1-16-2) women's ice hockey team fell to #4 St. Lawrence twice over the weekend by scores of 2-0 and 9-1...Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) kept up her points trend as she recorded an assist in Saturday's game. She has recorded a point in the last four games Maine has scored...The games this past weekend marked the eighth and ninth games Maine has played against a nationally ranked team this season in 19 total games played...Maine will take a break for the holiday season as its next series will be at CHA's Wayne State on Jan. 11-12.

University of New Hampshire: UNH scored four power play goals in a game for the third time this season when the 'Cats went 4-for-12 Dec. 8 at Mercyhurst...Seven of the team's eight goals in the series were scored on special teams (six PP; one SH)...The Wildcats surrendered a season single-high four goals to Mercyhurst on Dec. 7; the Wildcats had yielded a total of three goals in the previous three games...UNH's 17 penalties and 50 penalty minutes Dec. 8 at MC both marked team records...UNH's streak of 18 consecutive successful penalty kills ended Dec. 8 at Mercyhurst when the Lakers scored two power-play goals...Mercyhurst had not lost a home regular-season game since Nov. 30, 2005. That was a stretch of 37 games (32-0-5)...UNH trailed by two goals in both of last weekend's games; in the first 17 games of the season, the 'Cats trailed by two goals at any point of a game just once (Oct. 6 at SLU).

Northeastern University: The Huskies picked up their 4th win of the season on Saturday against BC. In 2006-07 the team didn't get its fourth win until Feb. 17. .It's also the Huskies' first win against a ranked opponent this season...Boston College had won the previous eight matchups. The last NU win against BC was also a 3-1 win at home...Northeastern remains perfect on the penalty kill in its last four games and is still undefeated when leading after the second period...NU goalies have now made 30+ saves in six games.

Providence College: Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) has registered at least one point in five of the Friars' last six contests, dating back to November 24. Over that stretch, Smith has notched seven points on five goals and two assists. Three of her five goals were power-play tallies. On the season, Smith leads the Friar offense with 13 points (6 goals, 7 assists), and she ranks tied for sixth in the nation with a .81 ppg mark among defensemen...The Friars are now on winter break until January 4 when they take on Niagara.

University of Vermont: The Catamounts have scored 17 of their 31 goals this season in the second period...Sophomore goalie Kristen Olychuck's (Kelowna, B.C.) 2.37 GAA ranks fourth best among league netminders and she ranks 18th in the nation in GAA among Division I netminders...Vermont has already matched its goal production from last season in 14 games (31 goals), in comparison to 32 games last season...UVM has the longest holiday layoff of any Hockey East team with 26 days between games. They return to action for a two-game set at Bemidji State on December 29 and 30.
