NO. 2 UNH TAKES DOWN NO. 1 HARVARD ~UConn and Vermont in action over Holiday break~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The only game last weekend involving a Hockey East was a marquee match up between the nation's top ranked teams, as No. 2 New Hampshire defeated No. 1 Harvard, 4-1, on Friday night at the Whittemore Center in Durham, N.H. The Wildcats will have a chance to reclaim their No. 1 national ranking on Tuesday after the victory over the Crimson.

UNH was led by junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) who posted two goals in the game, including her seventh game-winning tally of the season, which is tied for the nation's best total. Faber has scored a point in her last eight games for the Wildcats with 12 points (6g,6a) in that streak. Freshman goaltender Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) turned in another solid effort for UNH, making 22 stops in her 15th win of the season. Herman and junior blueliner Kacey Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) were key components in shutting down the sixth ranked offense in the nation, who went 0 for 7 on the power play. The 'Cats also got goals from Courtney Birchard (Mississauga, Ont.) and Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) to help UNH to its league-leading 17th win of the season.

After the holiday break, only two Hockey East teams will be competing before the new year. The Vermont Catamounts will play a two-game series at Bemidji State on Friday, December 29 and Saturday, December 30. No. 9 ranked Connecticut will face host Quinnipiac in the first day of play at the Nutmeg Classic in Hamden, Conn. on December 29. They Huskies will either Niagara or Yale the next day.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: The Eagles have outscored opponents in the first half of the season, 38-34...BC players have recorded 16 multiple-point games. Forward Deb Spillane (Franklin, Mass.) leads the team with six...Sophomore forward Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) leads BC with seven (5g, 2a) power-play points...The Eagles are undefeated (4-0-0) when they score first.

Boston University: Since opening the season 2-8-2, Boston University has gone 4-1-0 over its last five games, including its current three game winning streak... Allyse Wilcox (Jr., G, Grand Blanc, Mich.) sits in the nation's top ten for both goals against average (1.85, 9th) and save percentage (.926, 7th)... All 20 Terrier skaters that have started at least half of the team's games have notched a point in the first half of the season. Last season, only 17 players scored points over the course of the entire year.

University of Connecticut: UConn, after losing two straight games against ranked opponents will have a few weeks before traveling to Hamden, Conn. for the Nutmeg Classic, hosted by Quinnipiac University...The Huskies had the week off after losing to Hockey East opponent Boston College followed by a non-conference loss to No. 1/1 Harvard...During the month of December, the Huskies are 0-2 and anxiously wait to take the ice again on December 29 at Quinnipiac...Sophomore Jennie Bellonio (Guilford, Conn.) remains a big threat for the UConn defense, despite earning the loss to Harvard, Bellonio made 40 stops in the 2-0 loss, a performance that earned her Hockey East Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the week.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (1-16-2) will take a break for the holiday season as its next series will be at CIA's Wayne State on Jan. 11-12... Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) and Sarah Bishop (Agawam, Mass.) have combined for Hockey East "Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week" five out of 10 weeks so far this season... The last two games against St. Lawrence marked the eighth and ninth games Maine has played against a nationally ranked team this season out of 19 games played.

University of New Hampshire: UNH is 8-2-0 vs. nationally-ranked teams and that includes 3-0-0 vs. the No. 1 ranked team; the Wildcats have won their last four matchups against No. 1 ranked teams...UNH's attendance topped 1,000 (1,012) for the third time this season, marking the first time that has happened (in regular-season play) in the program's history...Special teams accounted for eight consecutive goals (six PP; two SH) spread over three games...In the game vs. Harvard, UNH scored on three consecutive shots spanning the second and third periods...Sam Faber has amassed 15 points (8g, 7a) in 10 games against nationally-ranked teams...Five Wildcats are averaging more than one point per game.

Northeastern University: When NU defeated then-No. 9 Boston College on Dec. 8, it marked the first time NU has beaten a ranked opponent since Dec. 8, 2001 when they posted a 2-1 win over No. 8 Brown. At the time the Huskies were ranked fourth. The last time the Huskies defeated an opponent ranked ahead of them was on Jan. 5 2001 when they beat No. 1, undefeated Dartmouth 4-0 while ranked eighth, and as far back as 1997 NU has never beaten a ranked opponent when unranked...The Huskies are 3-1 in their last four games. The last time the team went 3-1 Feb. 19-26, 2006. This month is also the first month the team has finished over .500 since Jan. 2004...Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) posted her second 30+ save game in a row and now has four on the season to her credit.

Providence College: Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ontario) ranks sixth in the nation for points-per-game among defensemen with a .81 ppg mark. Her ranking is the highest among league players...Freshman Forward Alyse Ruff (Tualatin, Ore.) ranks tied for first in goals scored in conference play with seven. Ruff is also tied for third in the league with three power-play goals...Sophomore Colleen Martin (Woburn, Mass.) currently leads the squad with a plus/minus rating of +7...The Friars resume play on January 4 at Niagara in their first of four straight games versus College Hockey America foes.

University of Vermont: The Catamounts have scored 17 of their 31 goals this season in the second period...UVM has the longest holiday layoff of any Hockey East team with 26 days between games. They return to action for a two-game set at Bemidji State on December 29 and 30.

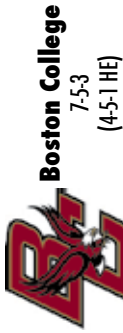
