TPS Hockey Player of the Month

Sam Faber - New Hampshire
 Junior Forward; Mt. Sinai, N.Y.

Sam Faber tallied four goals and three assists for a total of seven points in five December games. Faber recorded 3-1-4 in three games against nationally-ranked teams as well as 1-2-3 in two Hockey East games. Faber scored one game-winning goal and assisted on two others as she recorded a point in every game to extend her point-scoring streak to eight. Her highlights in the month included a two-goal game against then-No. 1 Harvard in which she scored the (shorthanded) game-winning goal. Faber also set up the (shorthanded) game-winning goal at sixth-ranked Mercyhurst. Faber led UNH in goals, points, plus/minus and shots (24) in the month of December.

ITECH Goaltender of the Month

Kayley Herman - New Hampshire
 Freshman Goaltender; Weyburn, Sask.

Kayley Herman, who was honored as Mission Rookie of the Week on Dec. 17, went 4-1-0 with a 1.78 GAA, .918 save percentage and one shutout in playing all five December games; she recorded 20+ saves each of the last four games of the month. Herman recorded her third career shutout with a then-career-high 24 saves at Northeastern. She compiled a 0.96 GAA and .941 save percentage in two league games. Herman went 2-1-0 with a .920 save percentage against nationally-ranked teams and compiled a personal-best 26 saves in a 5-2 win at sixth-ranked Mercyhurst College as well as a 22-save effort in which she yielded just one goal to defeat then-No. 1 Harvard.

Mission Rookie of the Month

Leah Sulyma - Northeastern
 Freshman Goaltender; Inuvik, N.W.T.

Sulyma was largely responsible for the Huskies' success, as she led them to a 2-1-0 record in December. She posted an impressive 2.00 GAA and a sparkling .941 save percentage in the month. She held Vermont to one goal, stopping 20 shots, for a 2-1 win on December 1. The following day she made a career-high 43 saves against No. 1 New Hampshire and on December 8 stopped 32 of 33 shots for a 3-1 win over then-No. 9 Boston College.
