## BOSTON COLLEGE SPLITS WITH NO. 5 ST. LAWRENCE ~No. 1 UNH downs Brown; PC shuts out Niagara twice~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – The Boston College Eagles split a two-game set with No. 5 St. Lawrence over the weekend with a 3-1 loss on Thursday and a 5-2 victory on Friday night at Conte Forum. Meanwhile, No. 1 New Hampshire picked up its 18th win of the season with a 3-1 victory at Brown, while Providence College earned a pair of shutout wins at Niagara.

BC sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) totaled 89 saves in the two games with the Saints. She amassed a season-high 53 saves in the win on Friday night, while she notched 36 stops in the losing cause on Thursday. Sophomore Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) had a two-goal effort for the Eagles, while Becky Zavisza (Suffield, Conn.) scored the game-winner for BC in its fourth non-conference win of the season.

The Wildcats, who are in the midst of a three-game win streak, upped their non-league record to 9-3-0 on the season. UNH senior forward Jenn Hitchcock (LaSalle, Ont.) became the 11th player in the program's history to record 150 career points, with two points (1g,1a) on Saturday vs. the Bears. Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) continued her strong play with 20 saves against Brown.

Providence, winners of six of its last eight games, was led by junior goalie Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.), who posted back-to-back shutouts against the Purple Eagles. Ciarletta had 25 saves in the 3-0 win on Friday and 15 saves in the 4-0 victory on Saturday.

No. 9 Connecticut earned a pair of ties with ECAC foe Princeton on Friday and Saturday at Freitas Ice Forum. Junior goalie Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) with 71 saves in two game against the Tigers. She had an outstanding weekend with 36 stops in the scoreless tie Friday and 35 saves in the 1-1 deadlock on Saturday.

Husky freshman goalie Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T) had 82 saves on the week in a overtime road loss to Yale and a 3-3 tie with Brown on Sunday at Matthews Arena. She tallied a career-high 47 saves in the loss to the Bulldogs and then followed that up with a 35-save performance on Sunday.

Vermont also dropped a two-game set to Clarkson on Saturday and Sunday at Gutterson Fieldhouse. UVM senior forward Kate Lesniak (Buffalo, N.Y.) played in her 118th straight game for the Catamounts over the weekend.

### TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Sophomore goalie Molly Schaus surpassed Kristin Gray to move in to the fourth stop on BC's all-time saves list with 1,312 saves...The Eagles killed seven of St. Lawrence's 10 power plays, even though the Saints took 38 shots on the man advantages...Senior forward Lindsay Wright (Calgary, Alb.) scored her first goal of the season in the 5-2 win over St. Lawrence; 12 Eagles have notched at least one goal on the year...BC scored five or more goals for the second time this season; the Eagles are 7-0-0 when netting three or more goals.

**Boston University:** The Terriers had six players with points in each of the last two games heading into the break...Freshman Jillian Kirchner (1-7-8) notched points in each of the team's last four games before the break, including seven assists in the final two games...BU goaltenders combined to allow only three goals in the Terriers' final three games of 2007.

**University of Connecticut:** UConn recorded two straight ties against Princeton this weekend for the first time since Nov. 19 and 20 in 2004. The back-to-back ties came against Minnesota State in a two-game series at Minnesota State, which ended in a 2-2 tie in both games...The shutout against Princeton on Friday, Jan. 4 was just the second time that they Huskies were held scoreless this season. The shutout was also just the third time the Huskies held an opponent scoreless in a game this year.

**University of Maine:** The University of Maine (1-16-2) starts up play again this coming weekend with a series at CHA's Wayne State on Jan. 11-12...Maine's last two games against St. Lawrence marked the eighth and ninth games Maine has played against a nationally ranked team this season out of 19 games played.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH boasts three skaters who have reached double digits in both goals and assists - Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) (14-15), Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) (13-11) and Jennifer Hitchcock (LaSalle, Ont.) (10-11)...Leah Craig (Seaforth, Ont.) assisted on every UNH goal Jan. 5 at Brown to match her personal best of three assists. Wright-Ward (9g, 2a) and Craig (1g, 10a) share the team lead with 11 points in nine road games this season...With the win at Brown, the Wildcats now have a 27-2-2 record, including 12-2-0 on the road, in first games of a new calendar year...UNH netted its third empty-net goal of the season in the game at Brown; the other two empty-netters were vs. BU.

**Northeastern University:** The Huskies have been near perfect on the penalty goal in their last six games, allowing only one powerplay goal (17-18)...the last NU goalie to make 30+ saves in four straight games was Marisa Hourihan who performed the feat in five-straight (Nov.19-Dec. 4, 2005).

**Providence College:** All seven PC goals this weekend came at even strength, including one 4X4 tally... With two shutouts versus Niagara, junior goaltender Danielle Ciarletta became the first Hockey East netminder to record back-to-back shutouts this season. She is the first Friar to accomplish the feat since the 2003-04 season when Ciarletta's former teammate Jana Bugden blanked Northeastern on consecutive nights on March 6 and 7. Ciarletta has not been scored upon in her last 150:05 of play...Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith has now registered at least one point in her last five games, dating back to December 2. In the five game scoring streak, she has scored three goals and added four assists.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont dropped a pair of home games to Clarkson... Both UVM goals this weekend came on the power play against Clarkson, the least penalized team in the nation...The Catamounts have scored power play goals in four straight contests after going 10 games without a PPG...At the midpoint of the season, 17 games, Vermont has exceeded several of last season's totals including victories (4 this year, 3 in 2006-07), goals scored (36, 31 in 2006-07), power play goals (10, 6 in 2006-07), short-handed goals (4, 0 in 2006-07) while vastly improving its team defense (2.81, 4.54 in 2006-07) and penalty kill (84.3%, 74.7% in 2006-07)...The Catamounts continue their four-game homestand hosting Connecticut Friday at 7 p.m. and Saturday at 4 p.m.

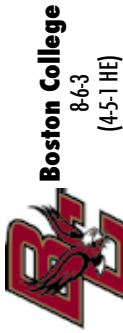
