FRIARS SPLIT WITH MERCYHURST; UNH STAYS PERFECT IN LEAGUE ~UConn sweeps UVM; BC plays tough at Minnesota~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The Providence College Friars hosted No. 4 Mercyhurst and came out of the series with a split after a 7-3 victory in the series opener on Friday night at Schneider Arena. Top ranked New Hampshire continued dominating its opponents with a 6-0 win at Northeastern on Thursday. No. 10 Boston College gave No. 5 Minnesota some tough games with a tie on Saturday and a loss on Sunday.

The Friars were led by Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.) made 35 saves in her eighth win of the season to help PC to its fifth non-conference victory of the season. Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) registered two goals in the win.

UNH ran its perfect league record to 10-0-0 with the victory at Matthews Arena. Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) totaled two goals in the game, while freshman forward Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) had a game-high three points (1g, 2a). Freshman goaltender Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) posted her 17th win of the season and her fourth career shutout, while Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T) made 40 saves in the losing cause for the Huskies.

Boston College's Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) helped the Eagles earn the 2-2 tie with host Minnesota on Saturday. She score both goals in the game, including the game-tying goal with 1:30 left in the third period. BC sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) made 110 saves in three games last week. She stopped 34 saves in the loss to No. 3 Harvard on Jan. 8 and 76 in the series with the Golden Gophers.

No. 9 Connecticut swept the two-game set with Vermont at Gutterson Fieldhouse with a 5-1 score on Friday and a 6-1 win on Saturday. Both Jaclyn Hawkins (Manotick, Ont.) and Jennifer Chaisson (Cumberland, Ont.) managed six points apiece in the series.

Boston University earned its fourth conference win of the season on Sunday afternoon at Matthews Arena. Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) had 23 saves in the Terriers' win and Jillian Kirschner (Frankfort, Ill.) extended her point streak to five games with an assist. Maine lost a two-game series to Wayne State by scores of 5-0 and 4-3 on Friday and Saturday. Freshman goalie Sarah Bishop (Agawam, Mass.) made 35 saves in the loss on Saturday.

Made 75 saves over the weekend and now has 30+ saves in six straight games.

UNH SPECIAL TEAMS
UNH has scored a power-play goal in five consecutive games (nine total PPG) and the Wildcats have scored four shorthanded goals in the last four games.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Forward Allie Thunstrom netted four goals in the past four games after scoring just five all season...BC killed all eight of Minnesota's power play chances in the weekend series, marking the fifth and sixth games this season it did not allow a power play goal...The Eagles are 2-5-2 against ranked teams...Goalie Molly Schaus has saved at least 30 shots seven times this season, including all three games this past week (34, 43, and 33).

Boston University: With the 3-1 victory over Northeastern Sunday, the Terriers extended their winning streak to four games... During that span, Boston University has scored three or more goals in each of its games while holding the opponent to two scores or fewer... While freshman Jillian Kirchner has notched nine points in the past five games, both junior co-captain Sarah Russell (Tewksbury, Mass.) and sophomore Melissa Anderson have earned points in each of the Terriers' last three games.

University of Connecticut: Cristin Allen (Pickering, Ont.) picked up two goals and one assist in the two-game series against Vermont. She led all defenders with three points on the weekend for the Huskies. Jennifer Chaisson recorded back-to-back multi-point games for the Huskies this weekend.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (1-18-2) traveled to Wayne State over the weekend for a two-game series...Maine lost the first game 5-0 and the second game 4-3...Jenna Ouellette (Winnipeg, Man.) and Robyn Law (Markham, Ont.) each had two points on the weekend...Maine scored its first power play goal on Saturday since scoring one against Boston University on Nov. 20...The Black Bears will host Northeastern on Sunday Nov. 20.

University of New Hampshire: UNH's 10-0-0 start is the team's best in the six-year history of Hockey East; the Wildcats opened with nine-game unbeaten streaks in 2003 (9-0-0) and 2004 (8-0-1)...Including last year's league tournament, the Wildcats are 27-0-2 in the last 29 games vs. Hockey East teams...On Jan. 10 at NU, the 'Cats scored two shorthanded goals in a game for the first time since Nov. 1, 2003, when current assistant coach Stephanie Jones and Allison Edgar struck at North Dakota...Kayley Herman's (Weyburn, Sask.) feat of an assist and shutout in the same game had not been done by a UNH goalie since Jen Huggon on Nov. 16, 2001...UNH has limited an opponent to single-digit shots four times this season and has recorded 40+ shots nine times...The 'Cats have held the opposition shotless in a period twice this season...Both Jennifer Hitchcock (LaSalle, Ont.) and Sadie Wright-Ward have recorded 19 points in 12 games vs. NU.

Northeastern University: Leah Sulyma's six-game 30+ saves streak is the most for a Husky since Marisa Hourihan's streak of eight games from Jan. 16-Feb. 4, 2005... Sunday's 3-1 loss to BU marked the first time all season the Huskies have lost a game after being shut out in the previous game. After being shut out by RPI on Nov. 3 the team posted a 5-4 win over Providence, scored a 3-1 win over Boston College on Dec. 8 after being shut out by New Hampshire in the previous contest, and tied Brown 3-3 on Jan. 6 after being shut out 1-0 by Yale the previous day.

Providence College: In beating Mercyhurst 7-3, The Friars earned their first win over a top-five ranked opponent since the 2004-05 season when PC defeated then fifth-ranked Mercyhurst 3-2 on January 8...The Friars have killed 27 of the last 28 power-play opportunities they have faced... Junior goaltender Danielle Ciarella's streak of not being scored upon was halted after 165:18 of play...Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith's extended her scoring streak to six games in the first game against Mercyhurst, before the Lakers ended her streak a day later. In those six games, from December 2 through January 12, Smith scored five goals and added six assists for 11 points. Smith now ranks fourth in the nation among defensemen with a 1.00 points per game mark.

University of Vermont: Vermont returned to league play and lost twice at home to ninth-ranked UConn... Sunday, the Catamounts saw their streak of scoring at least one power play goal in five straight games come to an end ... UVM has scored 11 power play goals this season, two short of the school's Division I record set in 2004-05 ... The Catamounts wrap up the non-league portion of the schedule heading west to play at WCHA St. Cloud State Friday and Saturday.

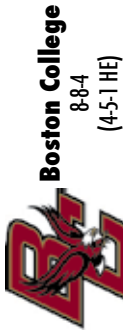
