PROVIDENCE TAKES THREE POINTS OVER THE WEEKEND ~Maine downs NU; UNH beats Dartmouth; UConn wins at BU~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Providence College battled hard in a 1-1 tie with No. 1 New Hampshire on Saturday at the Whittemore Center and then picked up its fourth win in six games on Sunday with a 3-1 victory against Boston University at Schneider Arena.

The Friars were led by junior goaltender Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.), who notched 53 saves in two games, which included 27 saves against the Wildcats. The Friars kept UNH's offense in check, as the Wildcat entered the contest with the nation's second best offense. Senior forward Danielle Tangredi (London, Ont.) scored a goal in each game for the Friars, including the game-winning tally in the second period on Sunday in the victory against the Terriers.

UNH defeated intra-state rival No. 9 Dartmouth on Thursday night at Thompson Arena in Hanover. Junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) had two goals for the Wildcats, including the game-winner and a penalty shot goal. Freshman Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) made 40 saves on the week with 22 saves in the road win against the Big Green.

Maine's Taryn Peacock (Calgary, Alb.) had a two-point effort with the game-winner to help the Black Bears to a 4-1 win against Northeastern in their first league win of the season. Junior goaltender Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) notched her second win of the season with 25 saves, while Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) had 39 saves in the losing effort for the Huskies. NU won the season series with Boston College with the 3-2 win on Thursday night. Sulyma notched 41 saves in that game for her fifth victory of the year. Sophomore forward Chelsey Jones (Lake Elmo, Minn.) scored her seventh goal of the season for her second career game-winning goal.

No. 8 Connecticut extended its unbeaten streak to seven games (5-0-2) with a 3-2 triumph at Boston University on Saturday afternoon. Sophomore forward Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.) recorded two points (1g,1a) in the win, including the game-winning goal with 7:34 left in the game. Junior goalie Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) picked up her 10th win of the season and the 30th of her career with a 27-save effort.

Vermont lost a two-game series with No. 10 St. Cloud State over the weekend. Sophomore goalie Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) made 53 saves on the weekend, including 22 saves in the opening period on Friday.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Sophomore goalie Molly Schaus recorded 46 saves in the 2-2 overtime tie with Dartmouth, which moved her into the third spot on BC's career saves list with 1,488. She passed current assistant coach Alison Quant (1,485)...The Eagles played to a 2-2 overtime tie for the fifth time this season; it was the first overtime game played at home...The Eagles have recorded 25 multiple-point games this season, with senior Deb Spillane leading the way with seven.

Boston University: Freshman Jillian Kirchner (Frankfort, Ill.) has recorded 10 points over the course of the past seven games (2g, 8a)...Each of the Terriers' 11 losses this season have come in games when the team has surrendered three or more goals...Allyse Wilcox's 33-save afternoon Sunday marks her fifth game this season with 30 or more saves.

University of Connecticut: The Huskies are now back to their winning ways, defeating BU for their third-straight victory. UConn's Dominique Thibault is rising in the UConn all-time record book, as she recorded her 32nd and 33rd points of the season on Saturday with two points (1g,1a). Her point total is the fourth best single-season total in school history, she needs only seven points to tie Jaclyn Hawkins' school record of 40 points from 2004-2005. Hawkins also leads the Huskies this season, as she has tallied a total of 18 assists so far this season. Hawkins still leads the UConn program in points (103), goals scored (55) and assists in a career (48).

University of Maine: The University of Maine (2-18-2) recorded its first win in Hockey East this season and their first overall win since Sep. 29 earlier this season against Sacred Heart...The win also marks the end of a 20-game winless streak...In four out of the last five games between the teams, the winning team has scored four or more goals...Maine is undefeated this season when scoring first and when scoring four plus goals...The Black Bears' 43 shots on goal in the game against NU marks a new season-high.

University of New Hampshire: UNH improved to 9-2-0 vs. nationally-ranked teams with a 3-1 road victory against ninth-ranked Dartmouth last Thursday...UNH scored its first penalty-shot goal of the season with Sam Faber's first-period tally in that game...UNH extended its unbeaten streak vs. Providence to eight games (6-0-2) with last Saturday's 1-1 tie...The Wildcats have won 20+ games all six years under the guidance of head coach Brian McCloskey...UNH has yielded a total of three goals in four January games...The Wildcats face off against Northeastern, a team they have shut out each of the last three meetings and a total of 227:38 overall, this Saturday.

Northeastern University: The Huskies' 3-2 win over BC on Thursday marked the team's first win when trailing after the second period. The win also ties their season win total from 2006-07...Leah Sulyma has made 30 or more saves in eight straight games and has posted that number in 11 games this year...This season the Huskies are 4-2-0 in one-goal games and games in which they score first.

Providence College: Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith led the Friar offense past BU, scoring two goals and adding an assist. In her last 12 games, Smith has 10 goals and seven assists for 17 points...Senior forward Danielle Tangredi scored PC's goal in their 1-1 tie with UNH, giving her a season-high six goals. The Friars are 4-1-1 when Tangredi finds the back of the net...In PC's tie vs. UNH, Danielle Ciarletta made 27 saves. In her last two games at the Whittemore Center, Ciarletta has stopped 67 of the 70 shots she faced. Additionally, Ciarletta has posted a 4-1-1 record in 2008 as well as a 1.15 GAA and a .961 save percentage.

University of Vermont: In its final non-league action of 2007-08, Vermont fell twice at No. 10 St. Cloud State last weekend...With freshman Sarah Ellins scoring her first of the season Saturday night, 16 different Catamounts have scored at least one goal this year...Brittany Nelson's goal with 13 seconds left in the Friday's contest was only the 10th third period goal of the year for the Catamounts...Vermont returns home to host Providence Friday and Saturday at Gutterson Fieldhouse.
