VERMONT AND PROVIDENCE SPLIT WEEKEND SERIES ~Terriers take three points; UNH wins vs. NU; BC/UConn tie~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Vermont picked up its first league win of the season on Saturday with a 2-1 win against Providence College at Gutterson Fieldhouse, after the Friars pulled out a 3-2 victory on Friday night in Burlington. The Catamounts, who last won a conference game on Jan. 7, 2007 vs. UConn, beat PC for the first time in 15 chances in the series history between the two teams.

Catamounts sophomore goaltender Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) had an outstanding weekend, posting 56 saves in the two-game set with Providence. She totaled 30 stops on Saturday in her first career Hockey East victory, which included 12 saves in the final period. Freshman forward Teddy Fortin (Brunswick, Maine) had a three-point weekend to lead UVM's offense. Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.) earned her 10th win of the season and Katy Beach (Middlebury Heights, Ohio) potted her seventh goal of the season for the Friars for the game-winner in the series opener on Friday.

No. 2 New Hampshire capped off a sweep of the season series in a 8-2 triumph of Northeastern on Saturday at the Whittemore Center. The Wildcats have a 6-0-1 record in their last seven games and need a win or tie on Saturday to match their eight-game unbeaten streak earlier in the season. UNH has nine games remaining in regular-season play. In 2006-2007, over the final nine contests, the Wildcats went 8-0-1 to finish the year.

Boston University took three points over the weekend against Maine in Boston. The teams skated to a 1-1 tie on Saturday, in the first ever women's game at Agganis Arena and then the Terriers earned a 4-3 victory on Sunday back at Walter Brown Arena. Black Bears goalie Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) stopped 45 shots on Saturday to help earn a point. BU's Jillian Kirchner (Frankfort, Ill.) and captain Gina Kearns (Norwood, Pa.) totaled two points apiece to take over fourth place in the league standings for the first time this season.

Boston College and Connecticut battled to a 3-3 tie on Saturday at Freitas Ice Forum. BC's Kelly Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) led the way with three points (1g,2a), while Nicole Tritter (Toronto, Ont.) amassed three points for the Huskies. The Eagles won the season series with one win, which came back on December 1. UConn goalie Jennie Bellonio (Guilford, Conn.) recorded 30 saves and Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) tallied 28 saves for BC in the stalemate.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Kelli Stack netted the Eagles' third shorthanded goal of the season; last year, as a team, they led Hockey East with 13...The Eagles scored their first power play goal since their 5-2 win over St. Lawrence on Jan. 4...The sophomore class leads the team in scoring with 40 points (22g, 18a). Stack leads her class and the team with 24 points (11g, 13a)...Connecticut was unable to beat BC this year in the season series as the two teams tied twice in Storrs, Conn., and the Eagles defeated the Huskies, 6-3, on Dec. 1.

Boston University: Sunday's 4-3 win over Maine was the first time this season the Terriers have won a game in which they have surrendered three or more goals...The four goals Boston University scored against Maine in the weekend finale were the most the team has collected since an 11-1 victory over Sacred Heart on Dec. 8...Since opening the season 2-8-2, the Terriers have been on a 6-2-1 pace over the past nine games.

University of Connecticut: UConn picked up their fourth tie in overtime this season. The Huskies have not lost in overtime yet this season, recording four ties and two wins (Rensselaer and Brown). Goaltender Jennie Bellonio tallied the first tie game of her career with the 3-3 overtime final against Boston College. UConn's point, goal and assist leaders, Dominique Thibault (L'Orginal, Ont.) and Jaclyn Hawkins (Manotick, Ont.) were held with out any points in the game, just the six time that both were held pointless in a game this season.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (2-19-3) traveled to Boston University for a two game weekend set. The teams tied the first game 1-1 but Maine lost the second 4-3. The tie on Saturday was the first in eight games between the teams...Seven out of nine games between the two teams have been decided by one goal or less...Maine had its first unbeaten streak of the season after Saturday's tie since sweeping Vermont last February...Neither the Black Bears nor the Terriers have ever swept a weekend series against each other...Maine goaltenders continued their streak of a least 20 saves per game. The streak stands at 27 straight games going back to last season.

University of New Hampshire: UNH has an 18-0-0 record when scoring the game's first goal and a 3-3-1 mark when falling behind 1-0...The Wildcats also have a perfect mark when leading after the first period (12-0-0) as well as the second period (15-0-0)...Last Saturday's game vs. NU marked the third time this season that the opposition outscored UNH in the third period; the Wildcats lost other two games (at St. Lawrence and vs. Princeton). Overall, the 'Cats have a 42-10 scoring edge in the final frame.

Northeastern University: Kristi Kehoe has seven points (4-3-7) in seven games against ranked opponents this season and is the only Husky to record a point in all five of NU's wins (2-5-7)...Leah Sulyma's (Inuvik, N.W.T.) streak of eight-straight games with 30+ saves tied a NU school record...The Huskies have six players with at least 10 points. Last season the team only had five players with 10 points.

Providence College: The Friar penalty kill unit has killed 13 straight opponent power-plays. In 2008, the Friars have killed off 35 of the 37 power-plays (95%) they have faced... Katy Beach netted the game-winner in PC's 3-2 win at UVM, which was her second of the season, and her seventh goal overall. Beach now has a career high 12 points (7g, 5a) on the season, a new career high. In the seven games in which Beach has scored for the Friars this season, PC is 5-1-1... In each of the Friars' 11 wins this season, they have notched at least three goals.

University of Vermont: In a pair of hard-fought one-goal games, the Catamounts split with third-place Providence falling 3-2 Friday night and besting the Friars, 2-1, Saturday...In picking up its first Hockey East victory of the season, Vermont put to bed its 18 game overall winless streak...It was UVM's first-ever win in 15 tries over Providence, a Hockey East charter member...Freshman Teddy Fortin had her third multi-point game of the season Friday with a goal and an assist...Freshman Molly Morrison (South Burlington, Vt.) scored her team-high sixth goal of the season Saturday...Vermont is at Boston College Friday and Saturday afternoons.
