Kathleen Smith - Providence Senior Defenseman; Waterloo, Ont.

Smith led the Friars to a 6-2-1 mark in January. She had six goals and five assists for 11 points, as well as a +7 plus/minus ranking. Smith had three games in which she scored multiple points in January and she notched a point in five of the nine games in the month. She had four points (2g,2a) in the 7-3 victory against then No. 4 ranked Merychurst and tallied three points in the 3-1 win vs. Boston University on Jan. 20.

ITECH Goaltender of the Month

Brittany Wilson – Connecticut Junior Goaltender; Nepean, Ont.

In four games played, Wilson played 249:55 minutes with a 0.96 goals allowed average. She made 115 stops in goal and allowed only four goals in the month, while recording a .966 save percentage to lead the Huskies to a 2-0-2 record in the month of January. Wilson picked up her 10th win of the season and 30th of her career with the 3-2 victory over Boston University on Jan. 19. She totaled 71 saves in the Princeton series on Jan. 4 and 5, making 36 saves in the series opener against the Tigers.

Kayley Herman – New Hampshire Freshman Goaltender; Weyburn, Sask.

Kayley Herman, who was honored as Mission Rookie of the Week on Jan. 21, went 4-0-1 with a 0.99 GAA, .938 save percentage and one shutout in playing all five January games for UNH. In three league games, Herman was 2-0-1 with a 0.97 GAA. .919 save percentage and one shutout. She was victorious in her only action vs. a nationally-ranked team by stopping 22 of 23 shots (.957 save percentage) at Dartmouth.
