NO. 8 UCONN AND PROVIDENCE SPLIT MATCHUP

~No. 2 UNH stays unbeaten; Terriers sweep UVM; Maine/NU split~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. — No. 8 Connecticut kept a firm grasp on the second spot in the league standings, as it split with Providence in a home-and-home series over the weekend.

The Huskies took the first meeting at Freitas Ice Forum on Saturday, as they shutout the Friars, 3-0, on a 21-save effort from junior netminder Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.). Sophomore forward Amy Hollstein (Pembroke, Mass.) had a three-point week (2g,1a) for the Huskies. The Friars were paced by Mari Pehkonen (Tampere, Finland) and Alyse Ruff (Tualatin, Ore.), who each has two point games in the victory on Sunday at Schneider Arena. UConn took the season series, 2-1, after a 5-0 win shutout on October 25.

No. 2 UNH took out Boston College, 2-1, in the final meeting of the season series. The Wildcats outscored the Eagles 10 to 3 in the three meetings this year. New Hampshire remains unbeaten in league play and extended its current unbeaten streak to 10 games (9-0-1). Wildcats freshman goalie Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) stopped 18 of 19 shots on Saturday at Conte Forum.

Maine and Northeastern also split their series this weekend at Matthews Arena in Boston. The Huskies earned their fifth league win of the season on Friday night, 3-1. The Black Bears came back the next day and got the split with 4-2 triumph to collect their first victory in a season series this year. NU also played No. 1 ranked Harvard tough in the Beanpot opener, in a 3-1 loss. Freshman netminder Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) made an amazing 107 saves in the three games for the Huskies, which included a career-high 47 saves in regulation against the Crimson. Maine junior goalie Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) had 36 stops in her third win of the season.

Boston University picked up three victories on the week, with win over Boston College on Monday and weekend sweep of Vermont. Terriers' forward Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) had a two-goal effort on Friday, while Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) posted 70 saves in her three wins. UVM netminder Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) made 48 saves in the BU series.

On Tuesday night, the Women's Beanpot Tournament continues celebrating its 30th anniversary and features three Hockey East schools, with Northeastern and Boston College skating in the Beanpot Consolation Game at 5 p.m., while Boston University and No. 1 Harvard meet in the finals at 8 p.m. Both games on Tuesday will be broadcast live on the internet by B2 Networks at www.b2livetv.com.

Katelyn Kurth, BC (Fr., D, High Bridge, N.J.) Recorded her seventh assist on the Eagles' only goal in the 2-1 loss to No. 2 New Hampshire on Feb. 9.

Chelsey Jones, NU (So., F, Lake Elmo, Minn.) Picked up four points in two league games with back-to-back multiple point games on Friday and Saturday.

Jean O'Neill, PC (Fr., F, Strafford, Pa.) Led the Friars to a 5-3 victory over No. 8 Connecticut, scoring the game-winning power play goal for the Friars. Had a +2 ranking in the game.

Kristen Olychuck, UVM (So., G, Kelowna, B.C.) Stopped 48 of 53 shots on the weekend against the Terriers.

Alyse Ruff, PC (Fr., F, Tualatin, Ore.) Led the Friars to a 5-3 victory over No. 8 Connecticut, scoring PC's fifth goal to seal the win as well as assisting on the game-winning goal.

Molly Schaus, BC (So., G, Natick, Mass.) Recorded 54 saves in the week for the Eagles, including 43 in the 2-1 loss to New Hampshire (2.54 GAA and a .937 save%).

Kelli Stack, BC (So., F, Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) tallied two points in the games for BC. She scored the only goal for the Eagles in the 2-1 loss to UNH on Saturday.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: New Hampshire broke senior Deb Spillane's (Franklin, Mass.) seven-game scoring streak on Saturday. Spillane racked up three goals and five assists in that time...BC held the Wildcats to two goals in the season-series finale after allowing four goals in each of the previous two meetings...The Eagles will not play in the Beanpot Championship for the first time in four years...BC is 6-2-0 when scoring first, but only 5-9-6 when their opponent notched the first goal...Boston College scores the most goals in the second period, racking up 27 this season; they have only given up 13 goals in the same stanza, but have allowed 24 final-frame scores.

Boston University: The Terriers' current four game winning streak matches their longest of the season, tying a span from Dec. 2 - Jan. 8...Sophomore Melissa Anderson had two two-goal performances this week, scoring twice in BU's 3-1 win over Vermont Saturday and in the 3-1 victory over Providence the previous Saturday...The Terriers' 2-0 victory Saturday marks the first time this season BU has won a game when scoring fewer than three goals.

University of Connecticut: The 5-3 loss to Providence on Sunday marked the Huskies first loss since falling to Harvard 2-0 on Dec. 7, 2007...The Huskies drop their first Hockey East loss since they fell to Boston College on Dec. 1, 2007...Brittany Wilson recorded her 10th career shutout in goal for the Huskies with the 3-0 win over Providence on Saturday.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (2-21-3) traveled to Northeastern for a two game set over the weekend...Pam Patterson (Miramichi, N.B.) recorded three points on the weekend with a goal on Friday and two assists on Saturday...Vanessa Vani (St. Catharines, Ont.) tallied a goal and an assist in Saturday's game...In Friday night's game, Genevieve Turgeon broke Maine's all-time career saves record. The record was previously held by Amanda Cronin who set a mark of 1,757 saves from 1998-2002.

University of New Hampshire: UNH is unbeaten in seven consecutive road games (7-0-0) and also unbeaten in its last eight home games (7-0-1)...Seven Wildcats are averaging more than one point per game during the current 10-game unbeaten streak; Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) leads the way with 17 points and Kayley Herman has an 8-0-1 record, 1.10 GAA and .940 save percentage in that span...UNH has a 5-2 record in one-goal games, a 4-2-1 mark when scoring less than three goals and a 24-1-1 ledger when allowing less than three goals.

Northeastern University: With their 3-1 win over Maine on Friday, the Huskies now have more wins (six overall, five HEA) than they did all of last season...In Tuesday's Beanpot action NU became just the fourth team to score first on Harvard all season. The goal, by Lindsay Berman, was only the fifth time Harvard has been behind this season and was the fastest score for the Huskies this season. The previous high was 59 seconds, also by Berman, vs. Connecticut on Oct. 27...The Huskies are 5-3-1 when scoring the first goal of the game and are undefeated (3-0-1) when leading after the first period...Leah Sulyma's assist marked the first time since the 1997-98 season that an NU goalie has registered a point. Sulyma is only the third Northeastern goalie to ever have a point...Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) is the only Husky to record a point in all six of NU's wins (3-5-8).

Providence College: Jean O'Neill netted the Friars' game-winning goal versus UConn while PC was skating with the five-on-four advantage, making her the only Friar to have at least one power-play, game-winning and short-handed goal this season. O'Neill is the seventh Hockey East player to do so this year...Brittany Simpson (Barrie, Ontario) notched the first two-assist game of her career...The Friars' win over Connecticut was their third victory of the season over a ranked opponent...Senior Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ontario) ranks fourth in power play goals among defensemen with a 0.93 mark.

University of Vermont: Vermont lost twice to Boston University at Gutterson Fieldhouse this weekend, 3-1 on Friday and 2-0 on Saturday...Sophomore goalie Kristen Olychuck became the first Catamount goaltender, and she is believed to be the first in women's Hockey East history to be credited with a goal scored picking up a goal at 12:27 of the third period in a 3-1 loss to Boston University Friday at Gutterson Fieldhouse...The Catamounts extended their penalty killing streak to 28 straight opponent power plays without a goal over the last seven-plus games...Vermont is now second in Hockey East in penalty killing at 86.5. A year ago, the Catamounts were last in the nation in penalty killing.
