NO. 2 UNH CAPTURES REGULAR SEASON CROWN WITH PC SWEEP ~UConn sweeps Maine; BC/BU, NU/UVM battle to splits~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – No. 2 ranked New Hampshire earned its fifth straight regular-season title with a weekend sweep of Providence College, while No. 8 UConn locked itself into the second seed with two victories against Maine. Boston College and Boston University, and Northeastern and Vermont split their respective series over the weekend.

The Wildcats extended their unbeaten streak in league play to 36 games (33-0-3) heading into the final weekend of the regular season with a 3-0 shutout of the Friars on Saturday at Schneider Arena and a 3-1 victory at the Whittemore Center on Sunday. Freshman goalie Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) turned away 43 of 44 shots in the series vs. PC, which included a career-high 27 saves on Saturday for the Wildcats. It marked her second consecutive shutout and sixth of the season for the rookie netminder.

Connecticut scored 12 goals in its series at Freitas Ice Forum vs. the Black Bears with a 7-2 triumph on Saturday and a 5-4 win on Sunday. The Huskies were led by sophomore Dominique Thibault (L'Orginal, Ont.) and Jaclyn Hawkins (Manotick, Ont.), who posted six and five points respectively in the series. Heather Linstad picked up her 100th and 101st career wins over the weekend, as head coach of the Huskies.

On Friday night, Boston College regained possession of fourth place in the standings with a 4-0 shutout of arch rival Boston University. The Terriers came back the next day and reclaimed their grip on the last playoff spot, as they downed the Eagles, 4-1, at Conte Forum. Sophomore forward Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) amassed a career-high four points in the win Saturday for BU, which included her first career hat trick. Sophomore forward Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) had two goals for the Eagles in the series opening win.

Northeastern and Vermont both picked up a game on the weekend with the Catamounts taking the series opener at Gutterson Fieldhouse, 4-1. The Huskies fought back on Saturday and headed back to Boston with a split after the 3-0 shutout. Freshman forward Celeste Doucet (Memramcook, N.B.) had three points (1g,2a) in Friday's win for UVM. NU rookie netminder Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) totaled 31 saves in her first career shutout on Saturday. She finished the weekend with 54 saves and a .947 save percentage.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Sophomore Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) scored all the game-winning goals in the last three Eagles' win...BC recorded its fourth shutout of the season in the 4-0 win over BU on Feb. 22...The Eagles scored two power-play goals in the same game for the first time this year...For the fifth time this season, BC lost after outshooting its opponent...Senior Deb Spillane (Franklin, Mass.) kept her scoring streak alive, now at five games, by recording an assist in the 4-1 loss to BU on Feb. 23.

Boston University: Sophomore Melissa Anderson's hat trick Saturday at Boston College was the second three-goal effort in Terrier history, after Junior Erin Seman notched one on Feb. 27, 2007 against Northeastern...Before Saturday's win, Boston University was winless at Conte Forum, going 0-4-0...With a 2-1-0 record against Boston College, this marks the first year since becoming a varsity program that the Terriers have won the season series against their cross-town rival.

University of Connecticut: UConn improved to 22-5-5 overall this season, to mark the program's most wins in a season in the history of the program. Dominique Thibault has recorded the most points in a single-season in program history with 47 (23g, 24a) while Jaclyn Hawkins has a new program high of 26 assists on the year.

University of Maine: The University of Maine (4-25-3) traveled to Connecticut for a two game set over the weekend...Maine's 18 points on the weekend were spread out between seven forwards...Freshmen Jordan Colliton and Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) accounted for six out of the 18 points...Junior Vanessa Vani (St. Catharine's, Ont.) moved into fourth place on the all-time assists record books with her three assists this weekend...Vani has tallied one goal and six assists in the past five games.

University of New Hampshire: UNH's 28 wins is tied for the third-highest single-season mark in school history; the Wildcats also had 28 victories last year; the top two marks are 33 ('06) and 31 ('98)...PC's 5x3 power-play tally Sunday ended UNH's streak of 65 consecutive penalty kills as well as the team's shutout streak at 217:12...UNH's PK is 78-for-80 (.975) in 19 league games...Martine Garland (Toronto, Ont.) has 17 assists in 15 career games vs. PC...In three games vs. the Friars, rookie Kayley Herman recorded a 0.65 GAA and .968 save percentage...UNH has outscored the opposition 41-5 during its current eight-game win streak.

Northeastern University: The Huskies are undefeated when leading after the second period (4-0-1) and are 6-4-1 when scoring the first goal...Kristi Kehoe remains the only Husky to score in all seven NU wins. She has a scoring line of 4-6-10 in those seven games...With her two assists on Saturday, Nikki Petrich (Flint, Mich.) became the third Husky to reach 20 points this season, joining Chelsey Jones (Lake Elmo, Minn.) and Kristi Kehoe. NU has not had three 20+ point scorers in one season since 2001-02...Leah Sulyma's shutout was the first for a Husky since teammate Sarah Belliveau (Woods Harbor, Nova Scotia) shut out Niagara 3-0 on Nov. 4, 2006...The Huskies' 3-0 win over Vermont on Saturday was the team's first win with a 3+ goal margin this season.

Providence College: Junior netminder Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.) has played extremely well at UNH's Whittemore Center. Through three career games at the Whittemore Center, Ciarletta has stopped 91 of the 96 Wildcat shots she has faced, good for a .948 save percentage...Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith ranks first in the nation for goals by a defenseman with 15. Smith is also fourth in the nation with a 0.91 points per game mark among blue-liners. Smith and the Friars were able to snap UNH's consecutive penalty-kills streak at 65 when she scored her team-leading 15th goal of the season while skating on the power play in Sunday's game.

University of Vermont: Vermont split a pair of games with Northeastern this weekend, topping the Huskies, 4-1, Friday and losing, 3-0, Saturday in its final home game...UVM's six victories double its win total from each of the past two seasons...The Catamounts went 6-10-1 on home ice in 2007-08...Freshmen Celeste Doucet and Teddy Fortin (Brunswick, Maine) lead the Catamounts in scoring with 12 points apiece, the most by Vermont rookies in the program's seven years in Division I...Vermont's four-goal outburst against NU Friday night was its highest against a Hockey East foe in its third season in the league...Twenty-three of UVM's 48 goals this year have been scored by freshmen.
