NO. 1 SEED UNH AND NO. 2 SEED UCONN TAKE EIGHT ALL-STAR SPOTS ~BU. PC place three players on All-Star rosters~

Eight of the 13 Hockey East All-Stars are represented by first-place New Hampshire and second-place Connecticut. The No. 2 ranked Wildcats are led by First-Team All-Stars Martine Garland (Toronto, Ont.), Rookie of the Year Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) and junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.). Garland was the lone unanimous selection on the First-Team roster. The 'Cats also placed freshman goalie Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.), defender Kacey Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) and forward Jennifer Hitchcock (LaSalle, Ont.) among the Second-Team All-Stars. TPS Hockey Player of the Year Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.) who headlines the list of Huskies on the All-Star Team, was one of two underclassmen named a First-Team league All-Star. Senior forward Jaclyn Hawkins (Manotick, Ont.) represented Connecticut on the WHEA Second-Team All-Star list. Providence's Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) was named a First Team All-Star for the first time in her Friars' career, while junior goaltender Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) was the First-Team All-Star from Boston University. The Boston College Eagles' junior forward Maggie Taverna (Howell, N.J.) and sophomore forward Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) on the Second-Team All-Star squad.

UConn's Jennifer Chaisson (Cumberland, Ont.), NU's Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.), UConn's Jody Sydor (St. Albert, Alb.) and PC's Alyse Ruff (Taulatin, Ore.) rounded out the rest of the WHEA All-Rookie selections. Ruff and Wakefield were the only two unanimous selections on the All-Rookie Team.
