Stack recorded 13 points (10g,3a) in the month of February for BC. She scored the last four game-winners in Eagles' victories. She had a +11 rating and scored at least one point in nine of the 10 games, which included four two-point efforts for the Eagles. Stack posted two goals on Feb. 1 vs. Vermont, Feb. 17 at Maine and Feb. 29 vs. Providence.

Wilson played in all eight games posting a 6-1-1 mark for the Huskies in the month of February. She recorded 1.54 GAA and a .934 save percentage for the month. In 468:23 minutes played, the junior allowed 12 goals while picking up three shutouts in goal for UConn. Against Maine on Feb. 24, Wilson recorded 26 saves, a game-high for the month of February as she picked up her sixth win of the month, 16th of the season and 36th of her career. She amassed 169 saves in February.

### Mission Rookie of the Month

Wakefield recorded 12 points (7g,5a) in seven February games, all vs. Hockey East teams, to lead UNH in both goals and points. She also recorded a team-best +11 rating and had a .259 shooting percentage. She helped lead the Wildcats to a sweep of PC with an assist on the second of two goals in a 25-second span that turned a scoreless tie into a 2-0 first-period lead, then the next day pulled the 'Cats even at 1-1 and set up the game-winning goal. She recorded a point in six of seven games with four multiple-point efforts that included back-to-back 2-1-3 games at Maine.
