## PROVIDENCE AND BOSTON U. LOCK UP FINAL PLAYOFF SPOTS ~No. 2 UNH sweeps No. 8 UConn; UVM sweeps Maine~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – Providence College and Boston University secured the final two playoff spots in the WHEA Tournament over the weekend, while Vermont and No. 2 New Hampshire also swept their respective series against Maine and No. 8 Connecticut.

The Friars got the one point they needed on Saturday afternoon at Schneider Arena with the 2-2 tie against Boston College. The Eagles finished the season on a high note with a three-point weekend vs. PC, after a 4-2 victory on Friday afternoon at Conte Forum. BC sophomore goalie Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) turned away 74 shots in the two-game set, which included 39 stops in the 2-2 overtime tie. Senior forward Sarah Feldman (Fall River, Mass.) totaled both Friar goals on Saturday to earn them the key point they needed to make the tournament for the sixth consecutive season.

Boston University picked up two victories over the weekend vs. Northeastern to secure the final playoff spot. The Terriers, who will make their first WHEA playoff appearance in the program's history, were led offensively by Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) and Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.). Anderson tallied three points (2g,1a), while Cherewyk notched two points on the weekend.

Vermont notched two victories at Maine over the weekend, for its first ever league sweep in its three-year membership in the league. Sophomore forward Chelsea Furlani (Colchester, Vt.) amassed six points (3g,3a) and a +6 plus/minus rating on the weekend, which included a career-high four points (1g,3a), tying a Catamounts program record. Sophomore goalie Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) notched 38 saves in the sweep for UVM. Black Bears junior netminder Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) set a school record for single-season saves (907) on Sunday vs. Vermont.

The Wildcats took out the second-place Huskies, outscoring them 11 to 1 in the two game match up. UNH shutout UConn, 5-0 on Saturday at the Whittemore Center and then triumphed on Sunday, 6-1, at Freitas Ice Forum to close out the regular season. Junior blueliner Kacey Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) had a four-point weekend for the 'Cats. Senior forward Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) scored her 150th collegiate point for the Wildcats on Sunday. Wright-Ward ranks 12th on UNH's all-time scoring list with 63 goals and 87 assists in 140 career games played.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** Fifteen Eagles have netted goals this season, including sophomore Tracy Johnson (Plymouth, Minn.) and senior Erin Blood (Plymouth, Minn.), who both scored their first goals of the season in the series with Providence...The Eagles have an 11-1-0 record when they score three or more goals...Seven Eagles have recorded multi-point games this season. Kelli Stack leads the team with nine and Senior Colleen Harris (Kenmore, N.Y.) and sophomore Gabrielle Beaudry (Cortland, N.Y.) registered their first in the 4-2 win over PC...The Eagles' sophomores lead all the classes with 60 points this season; they have scored 37 goals and 23 assists in the 34 games.

**Boston University:** Sophomore Melissa Anderson has notched seven points over the past three games, including four goals and two assists...Sunday's win marks the first time the Terriers have swept Northeastern in a season series, after going 2-0-1 against the Huskies last season...After this weekend's games, the Terriers end the season tied for third place - the team's highest finish ever.

**University of Connecticut:** The Huskies went 0-2 on the weekend against the No. 2 UNH Wildcats. Led by sophomore Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.), who picked up the Huskies lone goal of the weekend, UConn was out shot 82-30 in the two-game series. Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) picked up 49 saves for the Huskies in 83:41 minutes played but allowed nine goals and a .845 save percentage in the final regular season games of the year.

**University of Maine:** The University of Maine (4-27-3) hosted Vermont for a two game set over the weekend...Saturday afternoon's loss was the University of Maine's first ever loss to Vermont...Genevieve Turgeon broke a school record for saves in a single season during Sunday's game (907)...Vanessa Vani (St. Catharines, Ont.) tallied one goal and seven assists in the final seven games.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH enters the postseason with a 10-game winning streak and 16-game unbeaten streak of 15-0-1...The Wildcats went 11-2-0 vs. nationally-ranked teams and outscored them 50-20...In four years, UNH's six-member senior class has compiled a 112-18-13 overall record with a 70-5-8 mark in Hockey East and 63-5-9 ledger at the Whitmore Center...In the six-year history of the league, UNH has boasted the Goaltending Champion every year and the Scoring Champion four times...UNH is unbeaten in its last 10 games vs. both UConn (9-0-1) and PC (8-0-2) and has won all 15 meetings vs. BU...Six UNH skaters have recorded double digits in both goals and assists.

**Northeastern University:** Juniors Erin Reil and Colleen Sanborn (Woburn, Mass.) played in their 100th career games on Sunday...The Husky penalty kill was perfect over the weekend, going 9-9...The Huskies finish the season one spot higher than last season with a two-win improvement...in the last two weekend series, a freshman has led the Huskies in shots. Against Vermont Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) had a team-high 10 and against BU Alyssa Wohlfeiler (Saugus, Calif.) had four...Sunday's loss to BU marked the only time this season NU lost a game when leading after the first period.

**Providence College:** With PC's 2-2 tie against BC, the Friars qualified for post-season play for the 27th consecutive season, including their sixth straight Hockey East Tournament appearance. The Friars have posted a 7-2 record all-time in the Hockey East Tournament...Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) is second in the nation in goals scored by a defenseman with 15...Junior defenseman Erin Normore (Cambridge, Ont.) notched two assists versus BC this past weekend, giving her 20 points on the season (2 goals, 18 assists). It is the third consecutive season in which Normore has reached the 20 point plateau.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont earned its first-ever weekend sweep in Hockey East at Maine last weekend...The Catamounts won three of their last four to finish in seventh place and out of the basement for the first time in three years in Hockey East...UVM's eight Division I wins in all games and four in league play are also program superlatives...Saturday's 5-1 win at Maine snapped UVM's 34-game road losing streak...Vermont's last win was a 1-0 decision at Northeastern on Nov. 12, 2005...Vermont, which scored 15 goals in its last four games, returns 10 of its top 11 scorers for next season...The Catamounts' six goals Sunday was a team single-game high in a Hockey East game...Senior Kate Lesniak (Buffalo, N.Y.) tied the UVM career record for games played set a year ago by Kristen Norris. Lesniak, like Norris, never missed a game in all four seasons.
