NEW HAMPSHIRE TAKES THIRD STRAIGHT WHEA TITLE OVER PC ~Wildcats to host St. Lawrence in NCAA play on Saturday~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The No. 1 seed University of New Hampshire Wildcats took home their third straight WHEA Championship on Sunday afternoon with a 1-0 shutout of No. 3 seed Providence College on Sunday afternoon at UConn's Freitas Ice Fourm.

UNH junior forward Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) won Tournament MVP honors for the second time of her Wildcat career and was one of four Wildcats named to the 2007 WHEA All-Tournament Team. Faber netted the lone goal of the game at 16:43 in the first period as Courtney Birchard (Mississauga, Ont.) and Maggie Joyce (Hudson, Ohio) relayed passes up the ice to find Faber. The Wildcats also won the WHEA Championship in 2007 with a 2-1 vs. Providence and in 2006 with a 6-0 shutout of Boston College. Third-seeded Providence evens their record out to 16-16-4 on the year after their championship loss. The Friars won each of the first three league titles (2003-05). It was the fourth time in six years that UNH and PC met in the championship game.

Faber was joined on the 2008 WHEA All-Tournament Team by forwards Mari Pehkonen (Tampere, Finland) of PC and Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) of the Wildcats. PC's Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ont.) and Joyce were named defenders on the WHEA All-Tournament Team, along with freshman goalie Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) of UNH.

UNH heads into the NCAA Tournament with a 32-3-1 overall record. The Wildcats were the 2007-08 regular season Hockey East champions after finishing the year with a conference mark of 20-0-1, which marked the first undefeated amrk in league history. UNH (32-3-1) enters the weekend with a 12-game winning streak and 18-game unbeaten streak (17-0-1).

In the semifinals on Saturday, the Wildcats opened with a 8-0 win against No. 4 seed Boston University. In the late semifinal, the Friars gave No. 2 seed Connecticut all they could handle in the 5-1 triumph. WHEA Rookie of the Year Jenn Wakefield earned a game-high three points (2g,1a) for the Wildcats. Junior forward Mari Pehkonen (Tampere, Finland) led the way for PC with total goals in the victory on Saturday.

No. 2 ranked New Hampshire will host ECAC foe St. Lawrence for the opening round of the NCAA Tournament on Saturday, March 15 at the Whittemore Center (1p.m.). The Wildcats will faceoff against the Saints in a rematch of last year's NCAA quarterfinal game. This marks the third consecutive trip to the NCAA tournament for New Hampshire.

TEAM NOTES

Boston University: Sophomore Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) set a new team record for goals in a season this year with 16, surpassing the 13 scored by Laurel Koller in her freshman year during the 2005-06 season...The eight goals allowed by the Terriers in their 8-0 loss against No. 2 New Hampshire in the opening round of the Hockey East playoffs were the most the team has ever surrendered, eclipsing a 7-0 loss against Maine on Jan. 28, 2006...The five goals scored by UNH in the second period set a new record for goals in a period scored against Boston University.

University of Connecticut: The No. 2 Seed Huskies fell in the semifinals of the Hockey East Tournament to Providence College, 5-1. Sophomore Michelle Binning (Oshawa, Ont.) scored the Huskies lone goal as UConn's season fell short of their first ever NCAA tournament appearance. Senior co-captain Jaclyn Hawkins (Manotick, Ont.) and sophomore Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.) recorded the assists on the play. The Huskies finished the year with a program-high 22 wins in a season.

University of New Hampshire: UNH had a league-high three selections to both the First-Team All-Star and Second-Team All-Star squads; in addition, two Wildcats were named to the All-Rookie Team, including Mission Rookie of the Year Jenn Wakefield...Wakefield was crowned the Scoring Champion and Kayley Herman received the ITECH Goaltending Champion award...In four games vs. PC this season, Herman went 3-0-1 with a 0.49 GAA, .975 save percentage and two shutouts...In its three-year run as Hockey East tournament champion, UNH has surrendered just one goal in six tourney games...UNH has a 42-game unbeaten streak (39-0-3), including four postseason games, vs. Hockey East teams...UNH carries a 12-game winning streak and 18-game unbeaten streak (17-0-1) into the NCAA tournament...UNH has allowed more than one goal in just nine of 36 games.

Providence College: Providence is now 8-3 all-time in the Hockey East Tournament...Mari Pehkonen was named to the HE All-Tournament team for the second consecutive season... Junior goaltender Danielle Ciarletta has played four games this season versus UNH. In those four games she has posted a 1.74 goals against average as well as a .932 save percentage in just under 242 minutes of play...Senior defenseman Kathleen Smith finished the season tied for first overall in most goals scored by a defenseman in the nation with 16.
