WILDCATS PLAY MINNESOTA-DULUTH TOUGH IN FROZEN FOUR ~'Cats finish season tying school record with 33 wins~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – The No. 3 seed New Hampshire Wildcats ended their season with a 3-2 loss to eventual national champion Minnesota-Duluth on Thursday night at the Duluth Entertainment Convention Center in Duluth, Minnesota. UNH outshot the Bulldogs by a wide margin, 43-15, which included a 13-0 advantage in the second period.

Hockey East Rookie of the Year Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) opened the scoring just four minutes into the game for her 27th tally of the season, while Leah Craig (Seaforth, Ont.) scored the 'Cats other goal in her final collegiate game for the Wildcats. She finished with a game-high eight shots on goal. Senior captain Martine Garland (Toronto, Ont.) also tallied an assist in her final collegiate contest for the 'Cats. In addition to Craig and Garland, seniors Nicole Goguen (Truro, N.S.), Jennifer Hitchcock (LaSalle, Ont.), Diana Saly (Edina, Minn.) and Sadie Wright-Ward (Durham, N.H.) skated in their final contests for New Hampshire.

New Hampshire, who won their third straight Hockey East Tournament title, went undefeated in league play with a 20-0-1 record. The Wildcats also tied a school record with 33 wins this season. The head into next season they bring a 38-game (35-0-3) conference unbeaten streak into the regular-season.

On Thursday night, UNH's Garland and Hockey East Player of the Year Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Ont.) from the University of Connecticut were named RBK Second-Team All-Americans by the American Hockey Coaches Association.

TEAM NOTES

University of New Hampshire: UNH's 33 wins tied the school single-season record established in 2006...The Wildcats broke the school record for lowest scoring average against with 1.07 goals allowed per game...Jenn Wakefield became the first freshman to lead the team in goals (with 27) since current assistant coach Stephanie Jones accomplished the feat in 2002...Junior forward Sam Faber became the first player other than a sophomore to lead the team in points (with 49) since 2002, when senior Kira Misikowetz led the 'Cats in scoring; a junior had not finished as points leader since Carisa Zaban in 1999. Faber is the first player to lead the 'Cats in points in consecutive years since Zaban in '99 and '00...UNH held the opposition without a shot for an entire period for the third time this season when the Bulldogs did not record a shot in the second period of the Frozen Four semifinal game...The Wildcats had not allowed more than two goals in a game since Dec. 7 (4-3 loss at Mercyhurst), a stretch of 19 games...Jennifer Hitchcock led the nation in power-play goals (14)...Faber led the nation in game-winning goals (13)...UNH ranked No.1 in the nation in penalty kill (.934)...Faber (25g, 24a), Sadie Wright-Ward (20g, 24a) and Hitchcock (20g, 23a) each finished with 20+ goals and 20+ assists this season.
