TERRIERS TAKE DOWN NO. 4 NEW HAMPSHIRE AND MAINE

~BC and NU remain undefeated; UConn splits at Princeton; PC earns league win~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Boston University ended No. 4 UNH's league-record unbeaten streak at 40 games with the 3-2 victory at Walter Brown Arena on Thursday evening, while Boston College and Northeastern remained undefeated with victories over the weekend.

BU sophomore forward Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) stole the headlines in the league last weekend, as she tallied five goals on the week in two league games. She notched two goals in the win against No. 4 New Hampshire and she registered the third hat trick in the program's history in the 8-1 win over Maine at Agganis Arena. The win vs. the 'Cats marks the highest-ranked opponent BU has ever beaten in school history. Senior goalie Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) made 27 saves in the win for the Terriers on Thursday night.

Boston College remained undefeated with a 4-0-2 record, after a 3-1 win at Providence Saturday and a 4-0 shutout of Quinnipiac on Sunday at Conte Forum. Junior forward Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) led the Eagles with three points (2g,1a) on the weekend. The Northeastern Huskies also kept rolling with a 3-1 win against the Bobcats on Saturday to up their record to 5-0-2 on the year. Freshman Florence Schelling (Oberengstringen, Switzerland) made quick work of Quinnipiac with another 24-save effort in her third win of the season in four starts overall. Northeastern continues to lead the nation in scoring defense for the second straight week, allowing a miniscule 0.71 goals per game.

The Huskies of UConn shutout Princeton on Friday night with a 3-0 win, backstopped by senior Brittany Wilson's (Nepean, Ont.) 23-save performance. Wilson was named Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week for her efforts over the weekend, she posted a 0.70 GAA and a .972 save percentage in the two-game set with Princeton. The Huskies came up short the next night vs. the Tigers, 4-1, at Hobe Baker Rink.

UNH scored five goals against Yale on Saturday with a two-goal effort from junior forward Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.). The Wildcats top two lines accounted for nine of the 12 points in the game vs. the Bulldogs. Providence College also picked up a league win (4-2) on Sunday at Schneider Arena.

Vermont dropped a pair of games to ECAC foe Cornell over the weekend at Gutterson Fieldhouse in Burlington.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: Second shutout of the season for BC...BC has held its opponent to 2 goals or less in four of their six games this season...Junior Kelli Stack leads the team in goals (7), ppg (4), and is tied with Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) for assists (5). Stack has recorded a point in six straight games 10/4-10/26 to date)...The Eagles are 3-0-1 against ECAC opponents this season

Boston University: The Terriers are ranked in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine poll for the first time in program history ... BU is now unbeaten in its last five games, going 4-0-1 over that stretch ... Three games in that stretch were against ranked opponents ... The Terriers are 2-1-1 against ranked opponents this season ... The win over No. 4 New Hampshire marked the highest ranked opponent BU has ever defeated ... BU was 6-for-15 on the power play this week ... Sophomore Lauren Cherewyk tallied her first multiple-goal game on Thursday and her first hat trick on Saturday ... Cherewyk matched the BU program record with two power-play goals in a game in both games this weekend.

University of Connecticut: UConn earned its first victory over Princeton on Friday with a 3-0 shutout victory at Hobey Baker Rink...Brittany Wilson earned her 11th career shutout with 23 saves against the Tigers...the Huskies finished the month of October with a 4-3-2...Michelle Binning needs one more power-play goal this season to match last year's team leader, Dominique Thibault (L'Original, Ont.) who finished the 2007-08 season with six...Thibault led the Huskies with three points (all assists) at Princeton.

University of Maine: Vanessa Vani's (St. Catharines, Ont.) assist on Sunday gives her 50 career assists, only four short of tying Maine's all-time record of 54. It also gave her 80 career points, moving her into a tie for fourth place on the all-time points list. Maine is 2-2-0 at home, outscoring opponents 19-13 when playing in Alford Arena. The Black Bears have 11 power play goals, tying their total from the 2007-08 season. All of Maine's goals this weekend were scored by Freshman. Dominique Goutsis (Coquitlam, B.C.) scored on Saturday afternoon, Norum and Bond both scored on Sunday afternoon. Sunday marked the fourth time this season Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Quebec) has made 45 or more saves, she has 260 for the season.

University of New Hampshire: Four UNH streaks came to an end with the 3-2 loss at BU last Thursday: the league unbeaten streak ended at 40 games (36-0-4); the league road unbeaten streak at 20 games (19-0-1); the 16-game winning streak vs. BU; and consecutive penalty kills at 25...Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) moved into a tie for eighth place on the program's all-time assist list with one against Yale, which was the 87th of her career...Kelly Paton matched her career high of two goals and Angela Taylor (Paisley, Scotland) equaled her personal best of two assists vs. Yale.

Northeastern University: Through seven games, the Huskies have not been scored on five-on-five. Of the five goals they have allowed, three have come on an opponent's power-play, and two have come on extra-attacker situations...61% of Northeastern's goals (11 of 18) have come on the power play...Northeastern has been outshot in six of seven games this season, but are 4-0-2 in those six games...The Huskies' current seven-game unbeaten streak is the program's longest since Oct. 19 - Nov. 14 2003, when they strung together eight games without a loss.

Providence College: Freshman Laura Veharanta has seven points in 8 games played this season. She currently ranks second in the nation with 5 power-play goals...Senior netminder Danielle Ciarletta (Blaine, Minn.) owns a 3-1 record all-time against BU, making 98 saves in her four appearances against the Terriers...Providence outshot BU 115-76 in the three meetings last season.

University of Vermont: The Catamounts dropped a pair of games to Cornell last weekend at Gutterson Fieldhouse ... Freshman blueliner Shannon Bellefeuille (Fr., D, Kanata, Ontario) scored her first career goal against the Big Red Friday night. Prior to Saturday, she recorded a point in four straight games ... Erin Barley-Maloney (Fr., F, Raleigh, N.C.) scored her team-high third goal of the season Saturday. She is tied for second among the league's rookies in goals and is tied for fifth in freshman scoring with five points ... The Catamounts, who have a Division I program-best four-game road win streak, will be tested this weekend with road games at Boston College Friday at 2 p.m. and New Hampshire Saturday at 5 p.m.
