## BC'S STACK NAMED PURE HOCKEY PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR OCTOBER ~BU's Wilcox wins ITECH Goaltender honor; NU's Schelling named Mission Top Rookie~



### Pure Hockey Player of the Month

#### Kelli Stack – Boston College

Junior Forward; Brooklyn Heights, Ohio

Stack recorded a league-high 15 points (7g,8a) in October leading the Eagles to a 5-0-2 record in the month. She tallied two game-winning goals and four power play goals in seven games. Stack had multi-point efforts in all but one game in the month and she closed out the month with six points in her last two games. She totaled her 100th career point on Oct. 11 vs. Rensselaer to become the sixth player in school history to accomplish that feat.

#### Allyse Wilcox – Boston University

Senior Goaltender; Grand Blanc, Mich.

Wilcox went 3-1-2 in the month of October with a 1.95 GAA and .931 save percentage leading the Terriers to their first ever national ranking in school history. She went 2-0-2 in the month in four games against nationally ranked opponents and she gave up two goals or fewer in all six starts. Wilcox also registered 30+ saves on three occasions in the month. Made a season-high 34 saves in the shootout win at New Hampshire on Oct. 30.
