Stack racked up 13 points (7g, 6a) in seven games for the Eagles in November, including her first career hat-trick on Nov. 16 at Maine. She recorded a point in every game in the month, including three points efforts in three contests. Stack registered three points (1g,2a) in the 5-0 win vs. NU and had assists on all three BC goals at Princeton in the 3-3 tie.

Wilcox wins the award for the second straight month. She went 2-1-1 in November with a 1.97 GAA and .921 save percentage. Mission Hockey Rookie of the Month Genevieve Lacasse – Providence

Freshman Goaltender; Scarborough, Ont.

Lacasse helped lead the Friars to a 4-1-2 record over the month of November. She finished the month with a 4-1 record to go along with a 1.22 GAA and an impressive .966 save percentage. She finished the month with two shutouts having denied 30 shots in a 2-0 victory over Connecticut on Nov. 16 and 37 shots in the 1-0 defeat of Brown on Nov. 29. Lacasse registered at least 30 saves in three consecutive games, highlighted by a career high 51 save performance against No. 10 Mercyhurst.
