UCONN SWEEPS SERIES AGAINST VERMONT IN STORRS

~BC picks up two wins; Terriers take three points at OSU; PC beats Cornell~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – In the first week of play to start the second half of the season, Connecticut picked up four points in the league, sweeping its weekend series with Vermont. No. 7 Boston College won both its non-league games while No. 9 Boston University picked up a win and tie on a trip to Ohio State. Providence picked up a game against Cornell, as well.

Connecticut swept Vermont this weekend, first with a 7-0 shutout on Saturday, behind Pure Hockey Player of the Week Michelle Binning's (Oshawa, Ont.) three point game and Sami Evelyn's (Nepean, Ont.) two goals. Vermont's Kristen Olychuck (Kelowna, B.C.) made 24 saves in the losing effort. The Catamounts got on the board Sunday, but were unable to overcome the Huskies, with a 3-1 final score. UConn's Cristin Allen (Pickering, Ont.) tallied two goals in the victory, while Vermont's Kailey Nash (Middletown, R.I.) potted the lone Catamount goal of the weekend. The Catamounts also played a midweek matchup on Tuesday, hosting Dartmouth. UVM fell by a score of 4-1, despite Olychuck's 29 saves.

BC had a successful weekend in non-conference play. The Eagles first defeated Colgate 3-1 on Friday, when Maggie Taverna (Howell, N.J.) earned two assists and Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) stopped 27 shots. Back in action on Saturday, BC shutout Yale in a 1-0 overtime win. Mission Rookie of the Week Danielle Welch (Hastings, Minn.) scored 1:52 into the extra frame to lift the Eagles to victory. The game marked Schaus' sixth shutout of the season, earning her Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week honors.

BU traveled to Ohio for a pair of games against Ohio State, earning a win and tie on the weekend. The Terriers defeated the Buckeyes 5-3 on Friday, as Jillian Kirchner (Frankfort, Ill.) tallied a goal and two assists in the victory. BU took a 3-0 lead early in the first and never looked back. Saturday's game stayed knotted at two goals a piece through overtime. Holly Lorms (Wauwatosa, Wis.) tied the game at two with 1:31 remaining in regulation and netminder Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) helped BU hold on, stopping 27 shots in 65 minutes of play. Providence fell to Yale, 2-1, in a midweek, overtime matchup on Tuesday. Laura Veharanta (La Verne, Calif.) scored a powerplay goal to put the Friars on the board, but the Bulldogs prevailed in the extra frame. Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) earned 34 saves in the losing effort. The Friars went on to defeat Cornell 4-3 on Sunday, thanks to Alyse Ruff's (Tualatia, Ore.) two-goal effort.

Northeastern was shutout by Yale on Friday at Matthews Arena. Despite Leah Sulyma's (Inuvik, N.W.T.) 30 saves, the Huskies were unable to capitalize on their 22 shots on net. NU fell to Brown 2-1 on Saturday in Providence. Stephanie Gavronsky (Sherwood Park, Alb.) scored the lone goal for the Huskies in the losing effort.

Boston College: With two non-conference wins over the weekend the Eagles are 5-1-1 against the ECAC this season...BC has allowed only three goals in their last five games including three shutouts...The Eagles have not allowed a powerplay goal in 20 attempts.

Boston University: The Terriers earned their first ever win over a WCHA team with Friday's 5-3 victory at Ohio State...BU's seven goals this weekend were scored by seven different players...The Terriers have tied five games this season, already breaking the team record of four set in the inaugural 2005-06 season...Junior Melissa Anderson (Langley, B.C.) scored her fifth career game-winning goal against the Buckeyes on Friday...Junior goaltender Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) is unbeaten in her last five games, going 3-0-2 in that span.

University of Connecticut: The Huskies extended their game-winning streak to seven with a pair of Hockey East wins over Vermont this weekend. UConn was the only conference team to resume Hockey East play and was the lone team to win both of its games this week...Twelve UConn hockey players registered at least point this weekend while eight players registered two or more points against the Catamounts...In the midst of a 12-game homestand, the Huskies host Boston University on Jan. 10.

University of Maine: Captain Vanessa Vani remains only one assist shy of setting a new Maine all-time career assist record of 55...The Black Bears' upcoming games against Clarkson marks their final non-conference series of the season...With 14 games remaining, Maine needs only one more win to surpass its 2007-08 total...Of the Black Bears' four wins, two have come against opponents either ranked or receiving votes, No. 7 BC and North Dakota, in the most recent USCHO.com Division I Women's Poll.

University of New Hampshire: UNH has a 27-2-2 record in "New Year games" and that includes a 14-2-0 mark on the road...The 'Cats are 4-1-1 in head coach Brian McCloskey's tenure with three consecutive wins; they skated to a 1-1 tie vs. Princeton in '05 and lost 4-1 at Dartmouth in '04...Saturday's game at Providence will be UNH's first "New Year game" vs. the Friars ... It will also mark the team's latest "New Year game" since 1991 (Jan. 11)...In four games last season vs. PC, Kayley Herman went 3-0-1 with a 0.49 GAA and .975 save percentage.

Northeastern University: Leah Sulyma's .930 save percentage and 1.86 GAA this season are career bests...Sulyma's 30 saves against Yale moved her into seventh place all-time among Northeastern goalies in career saves...Prior to Saturday's game against Brown, the Huskies had not allowed a power play goal since Nov. 15...Ali Bielawski (Sr., F, Needham, Mass.) has set a new career high in assists (7), and matched her career high in points (9)...Florence Schelling (Fr., G, Oberengstringen, Switzerland) and Leah Sulyma (So., G, Inuvik Northwest Territories) rank first and fourth in Hockey East in both GAA and save percentage.

Providence College: Friars earned a gutsy come-from-behind victory on Sunday against Cornell erasing a 3-0 deficit to come out on top, 4-3. PC scored three goals in one period for the third time this season. Providence has only allowed three goals after the second period in the last eight games. Reigning Rookie of the Month, Laura Veharanta, continues to stay hot for the Friars as she has registered at least one point in the last four games (3g, 4a). She ranks second in the nation with eight power-play goals this season.

University of Vermont: Vermont returned to the ice for its first action since early December with three games last week falling to #3 Dartmouth, 4-1, at Gutterson Fieldhouse Tuesday and losing twice at Hockey East rival Connecticut, 7-0 and 3-1, over the weekend ... Two Catamount blueliners scored their first career goals last week. Sophomore Hannah Westbrook (Laramie, Wyoming) scored against Dartmouth Tuesday and freshman Kailey Nash (Middletown, R.I.) found the net at UConn Sunday ... UVM continues its six-game road swing at fifth-ranked Mercyhurst for its last non-league contests of 2008-09. The Cats and Lakers face off Saturday at 2 p.m. and Sunday at 1 p.m.
