## PROVIDENCE BLANKS NO. 6 UNH; NORTHEASTERN WINS THREE GAMES

### ~ UConn extends win streak to eight; No. 7 BC splits road series with No. 5 SLU ~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – Northeastern picked up three wins this week, shutting out No. 9 Boston University and sweeping a weekend series with Niagara, while No. 7 Boston College split its weekend series with No. 7 St. Lawrence. Connecticut also shut out BU, while Providence blanked No. 6 New Hampshire on Saturday.

Northeastern enjoyed a successful, three-win week, first blanking BU at Walter Brown Arena on Thursday. Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.) stopped 31 in her third shutout of the year. Lindsay Berman (Odenton, Md.) opened scoring 0:48 into the game, giving the Huskies a lead they would not relinquish. The Huskies then hosted Niagara for a two-game series, earning a 3-2 in overtime on Saturday. Alyssa Wohlfeiler (Saugus, Calif.) notched the game-winner in the extra frame. Back in action on Sunday, the Huskies had a little more breathing room in a 4-1 victory over the Purple Eagles. Wohlfeiler added two assists while Kristi Kehoe (Bakersfield, Calif.) tallied three points in the win.

Providence shutout UNH 5-0 on Saturday, as Mission Rookie of the Week Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) stopped all 43 Wildcat shots. Laura Veharanta (La Verne, Calif.) earned three assists in the victory. The win marked the first time the Friars were able to defeat UNH since Feb. 27, 2005 and the first time this season they have defeated a ranked opponent.

In their only game of the weekend, the UConn Huskies blanked BU Saturday, defeating the Terriers 3-0. Monique Weber (Rogers, Minn.) potted two goals in the win, while blue liner Jody Sydor (St. Albert, Alb.) recorded two assists. Netminder Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) recorded a season-high 31 saves in the shutout. The win marks Connecticut's eight straight victory and third shutout in that span.

BC traveled to St. Lawrence for a pair of games. The Eagles split the decisions, first falling to the Saints 4-2 on Friday. Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) stopped 32 in the losing effort. The next day, the Eagles topped the Saints 4-1, when Schaus added another 38 stops, bringing her weekend total to 70. TPS Player of the Week Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) netted two goals in the victory, bringing her weekend total to three.

Maine traveled to Clarkson, where they dropped both decisions on Friday and Saturday. In the first game, the Black Bears rallied from a 3-0 deficit to make it a 3-2 game, but ran out of time before they could overcome the Golden Knights. Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) made 38 saves in the losing effort. In the second game of the series, Maine fell 4-1 and Turgeon added another 34 saves, bringing her weekend save mark to 72.

Outside of league play, PC fell to Cornell 4-1 on Monday and Vermont dropped a pair to Mercyhurst on Saturday and Sunday, both by a score of 8-1.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** With a weekend split against St. Lawrence, BC wrapped up it's non conference schedule for the season...the Eagles finished the season 6-2-2 against the ECAC, Kelli Stack leads BC in non-conference play with 15 points (5g, 10a)...Eight different players contributed points over the weekend, and three players had multi-point weekends for the Eagles...Senior defenseman Stephanie Olchowski (Greenfield, Mass.) netted her first goal of the season and second of her career...BC's two leading scorers Kelli Stack, six assists (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) and Allie Thunstrom, (6g,1a) have recorded at least one point in four of their last five games.

**Boston University:** The Terriers were shut out in back-to-back games for the first time since Nov. 19-20, 2005...BU has now been shut out in three straight Hockey East games for the first time since Nov. 19-30, 2005...The Terriers have come up empty on their last 19 power-play opportunities...BU has given up a power-play goal in the last four straight contests.

**University of Connecticut:** Heather Linstad earned her 275th career win on Saturday...the Huskies collected their eighth-straight win with a 3-0 decision over No. 9 Boston University on Saturday...UConn has won the last four Hockey East games...as the Terriers went 0-for-3 on the power play, marking the third straight time UConn has held its opponent scoreless with the man advantage...the Huskies hosts their seventh ranked opponent with a pair of games against No. 4 Mercyhurst...UConn is 3-1-2 against nationally ranked opponents this season at Mark Edward Freitas Ice Fourm (3-2-2 overall).

**University of Maine:** After notching an assist in four consecutive games to tie the all-time record for career assists at Maine with 54 on Nov. 29, captain Vanessa Vani went the next four games without an assist before finally tallying the record breaker on Jan. 9... The drought was her longest this season, but she scored two goals over the four game period... During the weekend, goaltender Genevieve Turgeon reached the 2,500 career saves plateau as she now sits at 2,549, far and away Maine's all-time career leader...The Black Bears are only one win away from passing their 2007-08 total... Maine's Jan. 17 contest with Boston University will feature a ceremonial puck drop by two local athletes headed to the 2009 Special Olympics World Winter Games in Boise, Idaho.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH's 11-game unbeaten streak (9-0-2) vs. Providence came to an end with last Saturday's road loss to the Friars...UNH has lost both games this season in which it has recorded 40+ shots...The Wildcats have been outscored 19-17 in the third period...UNH has been shut out twice this season; the last time the 'Cats were blanked twice in a season was in the 2005 campaign...The 43 shots vs. PC marked the most by a UNH team in a shutout loss.

**Northeastern University:** Northeastern's Jan. 8 win over No. 9 BU is the Huskies' second win over a top-10 team this season, after a 3-0 win over then-No. 10 Connecticut Oct. 19...With 10 wins, the Huskies have surpassed their win total from last season (seven)...Northeastern goaltenders have combined for five shutouts this season; the most since the 2003-04 season, when Northeastern shut out seven opponents...Before their 3-2 overtime win over Niagara Jan. 10, Northeastern had not won an overtime game since Nov. 14, 2003, when it beat Clarkson 1-0...with her goals against Niagara Jan. 10 and 11, Kristi Kehoe set a new career season high for goals (13)...Northeastern has now matched its longest winning streak of the season (three).

**Providence College:** The Friars, after a six-game road trip, hosted #6 UNH to Schneider Arena and came away with a 5-0 decision in favor of Providence. The victory was the first over UNH for the senior class of 2009 as all five senior skaters registered a point in the game. The five goal difference was the highest margin of victory ever for Providence against the Wildcats. Providence travels to No. 7 Dartmouth on Tuesday, January 13, in hopes of earning their second victory over a ranked opponent this season. PC looks to change their fortunes against the Big Green as they are just 1-9 vs Dartmouth in the past 10 games.

**University of Vermont:** In its last non-league action of 2008-09, Vermont dropped a pair of 8-1 decisions at fourth-ranked Mercyhurst over the weekend...Four of the Cats last seven games have been against top 10 teams with UVM going 1-3-0...Freshman Erin Barley-Maloney factored in both Vermont goals at Mercyhurst scoring her team-high sixth goal Saturday and setting up a power play goal on Sunday...The power play goal by sophomore Molly Morrison (South Burlington, Vt.) was UVM's first in seven games to snap a 0-for-25 drought with an extra skater... Despite the dry spell, UVM now has 16 power play goals in its 22 games, one more than a year ago in all 34 contests.
