## BC, UCONN, UNH, PC ALL SWEEP WEEKEND SERIES IN WHEA PLAY ~Three points separate four teams atop conference standings~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – Goaltending dominated WHEA play this weekend, as Hockey East netminders posted an impressive six shutouts over the past week, including two by Pure Hockey Co-Defensive Players of the Week, Boston College's Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) and Connecticut's Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.). No. 7 New Hampshire captured six points on the week, while No. 9 Connecticut swept Northeastern in a home and home series. No. 5 Boston College swept its weekend series with Vermont in Burlington and Providence picked up a pair of wins over Boston University.

The Wildcats started the week with a 4-2 victory over Northeastern on Tuesday evening, behind two-point performances from Angela Taylor (Paisley, Scotland) and Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.). Back in action on Friday, UNH shut out Maine 3-0 at the Whittemore Center. Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) earned her second shutout of the year, stopping 15 shots. Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) and Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) each tallied two points. In the second game of the weekend series, UNH topped Maine 5-1 to complete its weekend sweep. UNH scoring was led by Maggie Joyce's (Norfolk, Mass.) three assists, while Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) recorded two goals. Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) made 47 stops for the Black Bears in the losing effort.

In a battle of the Huskies, UConn and Northeastern enjoyed a home and home series this weekend. UConn's Wilson did not allow NU to score once in the series, as Connecticut defeated NU 4-0 on Friday and 1-0 on Saturday. Wilson registered her fourth and fifth shutouts of the year, while TPS Player of the Week Dominique Thibault (L'Orignal, Que.) earned her second hat trick of the year on Friday. Back in action on Saturday, Wilson stopped 22 shots, while Thibault's goal lifted Connecticut over Northeastern for the sweep.

No. 5 Boston College headed to Vermont for a pair of games, beginning on Saturday with a 5-0 shutout of the Catamounts. Schaus stopped 19 shots, while ten Eagles got on the scoring sheet in the game. In Sunday's matinee, the final score was the same, while Mary Restuccia (Chester Springs, Pa.) tallied two goals and linemate Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) netted a goal and added two assists. Schaus earned her eighth shutout of the year in the victory.

In a home and home series, Providence swept BU, beginning with a shutout on Saturday. Mission Rookie of the Week Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) earned her fifth shutout of the year in a 34-save performance, en route to a 2-0 victory on Saturday at Schneider Arena. Back at it on Sunday afternoon, it was Katy Beach's (Middlebury Heights, Ohio) power play goal in the second that lifted the Friars to their second victory in as many days, with a 2-1 decision over the Terriers.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** With two victories against Vermont over the weekend the Eagles sweep the season series with the Catamounts 3-0...BC outscored the Catamounts 14-1 over the course of three games, including two shutouts...Twelve different members of the Eagles recorded points for BC this weekend and six different players had multiple points over the two game series...Molly Schaus set a school record for shutouts in a season with eight this year and her 15 career are also a Eagles school record.

**Boston University:** The Terriers have outshot their opponents in the last seven straight games, but are just 2-4-1 in that stretch...BU has lost all four games that were tied after the first period this season...Junior Melissa Haber has a 1.86 GAA this season, on pace to break the BU single-season record of 1.96 held by senior Allyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) from last season...The Terriers have been held scoreless on the power play in six of the last seven games...BU has an average margin of victory of 2.6 goals in wins and an average margin of defeat of 2.3 goals in losses.

**University of Connecticut:** Dominique Thibault became just the second Connecticut player to record more than one hat trick in her career with a natural hat trick against Northeastern on Friday night...UConn's 11-game streak of scoring on the power play was snapped on Saturday after being held 0-for-4 at Northeastern...Connecticut has won the last six Hockey East games, including over two ranked opponents (No. 7 Boston College on Dec. 4 & No. 9 Boston University on Jan. 10)...behind the puck stopping efforts of Brittany Wilson, UConn has denied its conference opponents a goal in the last three games...during this six-game conference winning streak the Huskies have outscored their opponents 20-2.

**University of Maine:** Jennie Gallo's (Castlegar, B.C.) team-leading 10th goal of the season also made her one of only four active Maine players with 30 or more career points... Genevieve Turgeon's (Lac Beauport, Que.) 81 saves in two games against New Hampshire places her in fifth place with 715 saves among Division I goaltenders...The Black Bears' power play percentage is third in Hockey East at 17.5%, a dramatic turn around from the 6.8% success rate from a year ago...While the chances are decreasing, captain Vanessa Vani (St. Catharines, Ont.) still can become only the third player in Maine history to tally 100 career points. She stands 11 shy with eight games remaining.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH's current four-game win streak is its longest this season...In three games last week, UNH scored a goal in eight of nine periods, and the Wildcats also recorded double-digit shots in eight of the nine periods...Maggie Joyce tied her career high of three assists Saturday against Maine...Sarah Cuthbert has scored both of her goals this season vs. Maine...UNH is unbeaten at home (9-0-3) this season and the Wildcats' home unbeaten streak stands at 25 games (21-0-4); UNH has never lost a Hockey East regular-season home game (57-0-9).

**Northeastern University:** Leah Sulyma (Inuvik, N.W.T.), made 38 saves against New Hampshire Jan. 20, increasing her career total to 1,285 and passing Kelly Dyer for sixth place on the all-time career saves list at Northeastern...Northeastern's sophomore class has combined for 24 goals, 27 assists, and 51 points, which amounts to 47% of Northeastern's scoring, and is more than the combined total of the nine upperclass skaters, who have combined for 17 goals and 32 assists for 49 points...Juniors Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.), Katy Applin (Palmer, Alaska) and Lindsay Berman (Odenton, Md.) have all played in 90 games for Northeastern, and are on pace to reach the century mark by season's end...Huskies goaltenders have combined for 11 30-plus save games already this season.

**Providence College:** The Friars finished the weekend with back-to-back victories over BU to win the season series, 2-1...PC holds the edge in all three completed series this season (BU, Maine, UVM)...In the last eight games to end the season, Providence will face off against six ranked opponents...Senior Katy Beach had the game-winning goal in back-to-back games over BU...Freshman Genevieve Lacasse moved into 8th on the single season saves list (556). Her shutout against BU on Saturday was her fifth of the season, the most by a PC freshman since Jana Bugden recorded seven in 2002-03.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont dropped a pair of 5-0 decisions to league-leading Boston College at Gutterson Fieldhouse last Saturday and Sunday...UVM heads into its final eight regular season games with an improved power play having scored 18 times at 11.6% in all games and nine times at 13% in league contests. In all 34 games last year it scored 15 power play goals at 9.7% and five PPG at 5.6% in 21 Hockey East matches...After 11 home games, Vermont ranks second in Hockey East in home attendance averaging 386 fans per game. It is the third straight season UVM has shown an increase in attendance.
