UNH'S KELLY PATON NAMED TPS HOCKEY PLAYER OF THE MONTH FOR JANUARY ~UConn's Wilson takes Top Goalie honor: BC's Restuccia earns Rookie of the Month~



TPS Hockey Player of the Month Kelly Paton – New Hampshire

Junior Forward: Woodstock, Ont.

Paton led the team with 12 points (6g,6a) in seven January games. Her January statistics included two power-play goals, one shorthanded goal, one game-winning goal, a .250 shooting percentage and a +7 rating. Paton ended the month with consecutive multiple-point efforts, including her first career hat trick, against BC to extend her point-scoring streak to six games. Paton was also named Hockey East Player of the Week on Feb. 2 for a five-point weekend against the Eagles. Also in January, Paton tallied 2-1-3 against then No. 7 ranked Dartmouth. In six league games, she finished with 4-5-9.
