## NO. 7 UNH SWEEPS NO. 5 BOSTON COLLEGE TO TAKE OVER FIRST PLACE

### ~Maine takes two vs. NU; BU downs UVM twice; UConn/PC split series~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – As the Hockey East season winds down, the race at the top of the standings continues to heat up. No. 7 New Hampshire swept No. 5 Boston College in a home and home series this weekend, while Maine took three points from Northeastern and Boston University swept Vermont. Providence upended No. 8 Connecticut before falling to the Huskies in overtime on Sunday.

Kayley Herman (Weyburn, Sask.) and Lindsey Minton (Richardson, Texas) held BC to just two goals in both Thursday and Friday's contests. The Wildcats earned a 4-2 victory at home on Thursday evening, while Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) recorded three assists and Jenn Wakefield (Pickering, Ont.) notched two goals in the victory. The next night at Conte Forum, the 'Cats took a 5-2 victory. Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) registered a hat trick, bringing her two-day total to five points. Micaela Long (South Boston, Mass.) notched three points in the decisive victory.

UConn split its weekend series with Providence, first falling to the Friars 5-1 at Schneider Arena. Genevieve Lacasse (Scarborough, Ont.) stopped 34 of UConn's shots in the victory, while 12 Friars got on the scoring sheet, led by Erin Normore (Cambridge, Ont.) and Laura Veharanta's (La Verne, Calif.) two points apiece. Back in action on Sunday, the Huskies stopped PC's three-game winning streak, with a 2-1 overtime win. Nicole Tritter (Toronto, Ont.) scored with less than a minute remaining in overtime to lift the Huskies to victory. Lacasse stopped another 34 shots, bringing her weekend total to 68.

BU hosted Vermont for a pair of games this weekend, sweeping the Catamounts 3-2 and 4-0 on Friday and Saturday, respectively. Gina Kearns' (Norwood, Pa.) goal with just under three minutes remaining in the game on Friday lifted the Terriers to victory in the first game. Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) stopped all 23 Vermont shots on Saturday en route to the 4-0 shutout. Linemates Lauren Cherewyk (St. Albert, Alb.) and Erin Seman (Ramsey, Minn.) each tallied a goal and an assist in the victory.

Maine captured three points from Northeastern this weekend, defeating the Huskies 4-2 on Friday and skating to a 2-2 tie on Saturday. Jennie Gallo (Castlegar, B.C.) tallied three assists in the victory on Friday, while teammate Myriam Croussette (Baie-Comeau, Que.) notched two goals and an assist. Alyssa Wohlfeiler (Saugus, Calif.) potted a goal and added an assist in the losing effort. In Saturday's matchup, Vanessa Vani (Mississauga, Ont.) tallied a goal and assist for Maine, while teammate Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) stopped 37 shots to keep the Black Bears close.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** The two losses to New Hampshire, marks the first back-to-back losses for the Eagles in the 2008-2009 season...BC outshot UNH 65-54 in the two game series...With a goal in Thursday's game at New Hampshire, junior Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) is one point away from 100 career points...seniors Becky Zavisza (Suffield, Conn.) and Meghan Fardelmann continue to move closer to the hundred point mark as well. Zavisza had an assist in Thursday's game to crack 90 career points and Fardelmann's goal in Friday's game puts her at 93...The Eagles will be looking to play in their third Beanpot championship game in four years when they take on host school Northeastern in the first round of the mid-winter classic on Tuesday at 8 p.m.

**Boston University:** The Terriers clinched a return trip to the Hockey East tournament with their two-game sweep of Vermont...Senior Gina Kearns (Norwood, Pa.) scored the game-winning goal with less than three minutes to play on Friday to lift the Terriers to a 3-2 win and bring Kearns to 96 career points as she seeks to become the first Terrier to reach 100 points... Junior Melissa Haber recorded her fifth career shutout and first since Jan. 27, 2007, against Vermont on Saturday. Haber has now faced the Catamounts three times in her career and has never allowed a goal...It was BU's second shutout of the season after senior Alyse Wilcox (Grand Blanc, Mich.) blanked Princeton on Nov. 14...The Terriers face Harvard in the opening round of the Beanpot on Tuesday, a rematch of last season's championship game won by the Crimson...BU will be hoping to appear in the Beanpot championship game for the third straight season.

**University of Connecticut:** The Huskies snapped a three-game winning streak with a 2-1 overtime victory over Providence on Sunday afternoon...Nicole Tritter scored her first gamewinner of the season 50 seconds into the extra session...UConn scored twice on the power play against the Friars, including Dominique Thibault's game-tying goal in the third period...Connecticut wraps up the regular-season series with Boston University this weekend.

**University of Maine:** Maine picked up four points over the weekend and moved just four points shy of a tie for the final playoff spot in the Hockey East standings...Jennie Gallo continues her stellar sophomore campaign by netting a team-high 11 goals, six in conference play, after leading the team in 2007-08 with seven goals...Vanessa Vani stands just seven points shy, with six games remaining, of becoming only the third player in program history to tally 100 career points...Goaltender Genevieve Turgeon is just 125 saves away from breaking the Maine single season record for saves, which she set last season with 907...The Black Bears travel to Boston College for a rematch after Maine's 5-3 victory in Orono on Nov. 16, the Black Bears remain the only team this season to score five goals on standout netminder Molly Schaus.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH extended its unbeaten streak vs. BC to seven games (6-0-1) with last week's home-and-home sweep...UNH netted a goal in 11 consecutive periods before being held scoreless in the second period last Friday...UNH's four first-period goals Friday at BC matched the team's highest goal output in the opening stanza this season...UNH is 3-0-2 in its last five games against nationally-ranked teams.

**Northeastern University:** Katy Applin (Palmer, Alaska) has set a new career high in goal...Northeastern is now one point away from matching its HEA point total from 2007-08...Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.) has matched her career highs in assists and points...Colleen Sanborn (Woburn, Mass.) and Erin Reil (North Berwick, Maine) have never missed a game in their Northeastern careers...with a tie against Maine, the Huskies snapped a five-game losing skid.

**Providence College:** After a split of the weekend series with No. 8 Connecticut, the Friars took the season series with the Huskies, 2-1... The Friars have won all four season series this year (BU, UM, UC, UVM)...
