NO. 5 UNH SWEEPS VERMONT; NO. 7 BC TAKES TWO FROM MAINE

~BU downs No. 9 UConn twice; NU/PC split series~

WAKEFIELD, Mass. – Women's Hockey East teams are still neck and neck at the top of the standings, and after some interesting series this weekend, the race is as close as ever. Boston University collected four points from No. 9 Connecticut on the weekend, while No. 7 Boston College swept Maine. No. 5 New Hampshire swept its series with Vermont and Northeastern split its two-game set with Providence.

BC first saw action Monday night in the first round of the Beanpot, earning a 3-1 victory over Northeastern. TPS Hockey Player of the Week Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) and Allie Thunstrom (Maplewood, Minn.) each tallied two points in the victory, as Thunstrom's two points lifted her to the 100-point mark in her career as an Eagle. Back in action on Saturday, BC blanked Maine 2-0, behind Molly Schaus' (Natick, Mass.) eighth shutout of the year. Thunstrom's short-handed tally made the difference for BC. Stack rounded out a six-point week by tallying two goals and an assist in a 6-2 win over the Black Bears on Sunday, while teammate Mary Restuccia (Chester Springs, Pa.) notched three points in the victory, as well.

New Hampshire headed to Burlington for a two-game set against UVM, sweeping the Catamounts on the weekend. The Wildcats earned a 3-1 victory on Saturday, behind Jenn Wakefield's (Pickering, Ont.) two goals. Back at Gutterson on Sunday, UNH earned a commanding 6-2 win. Kelly Paton (Woodstock, Ont.) notched two goals and two assists, while Sam Faber (Mt. Sinai, N.Y.) registered four assists. Teammate Kacey Bellamy (Westfield, Mass.) tallied two points, also bringing her to the 100 career points benchmark.

BU took four points from UConn on the weekend, earning a shootout victory on Friday in Storrs and a 3-1 win at Walter Brown Arena on Saturday afternoon. Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) stopped 30 shots for the Terriers in Friday's win, while Sarah Russell (Tewksbury, Mass.) assisted on both BU goals. In Saturday's matchup, blue liner and Mission Rookie of the Week Tara Watchorn (Newcastle, Ont.) picked up a goal and an assist in the victory. The Terriers fell to Harvard earlier in the week, in the opening round of the Beanpot.

Providence and Northeastern split their home and home series, each proving that home ice really had its advantage. In Friday's game, the Friars pulled out a 3-2 overtime victory at Schneider Arena. Abby Gauthier (Lynn, Mass.) registered two assists for PC, while teammate Mari Pehkonen (Tampere, Finland) got the game-winner with one minute remaining in the extra stanza. Florence Schelling (Oberengstringen, Switzerland) made an impressive 53 saves in the losing effort. Back in action on Saturday night, the Huskies earned a 3-2 victory over the Friars behind another strong start by Schelling. With 42 stops on the night, her weekend total finished at 95 saves, earning her Pure Hockey Defensive Player of the Week Honors. Teammate Julia Marty (Nussbaumen, Switzerland) tallied two points in the victory.

TEAM NOTES

Boston College: The Eagles win the season series with Maine 2 games to one over the weekend outscoring the Black Bears 11-7 in three games...After losing their first back-to-back games of the season to UNH to close out January, BC is riding a three game win streak into the championship game of the Women's Beanpot on Tuesday at 8 p.m...Seniors Meghan Fardelmann and Becky Zavisza continue to move closer to the 100 point mark, each tallied points over the weekend and now have 95 and 92 points respectively.

Boston University: The Terriers captured four points in Hockey East play last weekend and have now won their last four conference games...BU won the Hockey East season series against Connecticut for the first time ever...The Terriers seven-round shootout with Connecticut with the longest shootout in Hockey East this season...BU is 4-0 in shootouts and has won as many shootouts as the rest of the league combined...With six ties this season, the Terriers have set a program record and have the most ties of any team in the nation...BU will face Northeastern in the consolation game of the Beanpot on Tuesday and face the Huskies in three of the final four games of the regular season.

University of Connecticut: The stretch of recent Hockey East success for the No. 9 UConn was halted by Boston University last weekend. UConn dropped a pair of games to the Terriers in its home-and-away series. On Friday, the Huskies a pair of unanswered goals by BU with a pair of their own only to fall short in a seven-round shootout at Mark Edward Freitas Ice Forum. Sami Evelyn got things started with a power-play goal just past the five-minute mark of the third period. Michelle Binning scored her 16th of the season midway point of the final period of regulation to tie the game (2-2)...The conference regular-season continues to wind down for UConn with a two-game stint at Maine next weekend.

University of Maine: Vanessa Vani continues her hunt to become only the third player in program history to tally 100 career points, she stands just six shy with four games remaining...If goaltender Genevieve Turgeon averages approximately 20 saves per game in the final four contests she will break the Maine single-season save record she set last season of 907... After only tallying 11 power plays goals in 2007-08, the Black Bears not only have 24 this season, but three players (Jenna Ouellette, 5, Jennie Gallo, 4, Amy Stech, 4) have topped last season's team-high of three... Maine's playoff hopes are still alive, starting the week six points behind sixth place Northeastern.

University of New Hampshire: UNH concludes the regular season with five games in a 10-day span (Feb. 13-22) ... UNH has scored a goal in 22 of 24 periods during its eight-game winning streak ... Kelly Paton recorded a career-high four points (2g, 2a) Sunday at UVM ... Sam Faber matched her personal best of four assists in that game ... UNH leads the nation with nine shorthanded goals.

Northeastern University: Ali Bielawski has set a new career high with six goals this season...With its win over Providence, Northeastern matches its Hockey East point total from last season with four conference games left to play. The total is also the team's highest since 2003-04... Florence Schelling set a Hockey East season-high with 53 saves against Providence Saturday night at Schneider Arena, topping Providence's own Genevieve Lacasse's 51-save performance against Mercyhurst Nov. 21...With its win over the Friars Feb. 7, Northeastern claimed the season-series victory over Providence for the first time since 2001-02.

Providence College: The Friars split this weekend with Northeastern... With the loss, PC is now 4-1 in season series coming into the final two weekends against UNH and BC...Genevieve Lacasse gave up more than two goals (3) for only the second time in conference play this season... Her 1.90 goals against average places her fourth all-time on the single season record books at Providence...PC faces off against arch rival New Hampshire in a home-and-home matchup this weekend... Providence blanked then No. 6 UNH, 5-0, in Providence back on Jan. 10... All five senior skaters registered a point in the victory.

University of Vermont: Vermont played tough against league-leading New Hampshire but dropped a hard-fought 3-1 decision Saturday and lost 6-2 Sunday on Skating Strides Against Breast Cancer Day at Gutterson Fieldhouse...Celeste Doucet scored a goal in each game against the fifth-ranked Wildcats...Freshman Erin Barley-Maloney (Raleigh, N.C.) had an assist Saturday for her team-high 17th point of the season. She is now tied for the second-most in a single-season among Division I Catamounts, two behind the record set by Hilary Johnson in 2003-04...Freshman Kyleigh Palmer had a goal and an assist Sunday, her third multi-point game of the season... Sophomore Teddy Fortin (Brunswick, Maine) set up both goals Sunday for her fourth multi-point game of the season.
