## NO. 5 UNH WINS AT LEAST SHARE OF REGULAR SEASON TITLE WITH PC SWEEP

### ~7th WHEA playoff field set heading into last weekend of regular season~

**WAKEFIELD, Mass.** – The No. 5 ranked New Hampshire Wildcats captured a piece of their sixth straight regular-season championship on Saturday night with a 4-1 win against Providence College and a weekend sweep of the Friars, while Northeastern clinched the final spot the new six-team WHEA playoff format with a win vs. Vermont on Sunday at Matthews Arena. Boston College also won a shootout on Saturday afternoon against archrival BU and UConn swept Maine in Orono.

The Wildcats can clinch the regular-season title outright this weekend by gaining one point, or by Boston College losing one point. UNH earned a slim 3-2 win on Friday at Schneider Arena and then followed that up with a 4-1 victory on Saturday at the Whittemore Center. Freshman goalie Lindsey Minton (Richardson, Texas) won both games for the 'Cats with a 1.50 GAA and a .923 save percentage on the weekend, which included 20 saves in the win on Friday. Providence rookie forward Kate Bacon (Chanhassen, Minn.) recorded a goal in each game of the series for the Friars. The Wildcats own the nation's longest unbeaten streak with a 10-game winning streak.

Northeastern and Vermont skated in a pair of 4-3 games over the weekend in Boston. The Catamounts came away with the victory on Saturday at Matthews Arena and then the Huskies reversed the score on Sunday in the series finale. The Catamounts were led by sophomore blueliner Peggy Wakeham (Bay Roberts, Nfld.) posting a five-point (1g,4a) weekend. Annie Hogan (Medford, Mass.) and Alyssa Wohlfeiler (Saugus, Calif.) both had three point games in NU's win Sunday.

The Terriers and Eagles battled to a 3-3 score through 65 minutes of play of Saturday afternoon at Conte Forum. Freshman forward Mary Restuccia (Chester Springs, Pa.) gave the Eagles the shootout winner. Jennelle Kohanchuk (Winnipeg, Man.) recorded two goals in the loss, while Melissa Haber (Toronto, Ont.) notched 23 saves for the Terriers in net. BC was victorious in the Beanpot on Tuesday with a 1-0 shutout of Harvard at Matthews Arena. BC netminder Molly Schaus (Natick, Mass.) totaled a season-high 40 saves in her 20th victory of the season, while classmate Kelli Stack (Brooklyn Heights, Ohio) was named the Beanpot MVP with three points (2g,1a), including the game-winning tally in the title game.

UConn picked up four points at Maine to keep the race in the standings close. UConn goalie Brittany Wilson (Nepean, Ont.) recorded 42 saves on the weekend, while Maine goalie Genevieve Turgeon (Lac Beauport, Que.) totaled 63 stops in the losing effort for the Black Bears.

## TEAM NOTES

**Boston College:** BC concluded the three game regular season series against Boston University this weekend with a shootout win. It is only the second time this season the Eagles have advanced to a shootout...The Eagles are now unbeaten in their last five (4-0-1)...Seniors Meghan Fardelmann and Becky Zavisza both continued their journey towards 100 points with tallies in Saturday's game...Fardelmann netted a goal to put her career tally at 97 and Zavisza had two points (1g, 1a) to bring her to 94...The Eagles close out the regular season with a home-and-home against Providence College next weekend.

**Boston University:** The Terriers are 4-1-2 in their last seven contests...BU junior Melissa Haber's 1.73 GAA in league play is second best among WHEA netminders and her .615 win percentage is fourth best...The Terriers with 15 wins this season, have matched their win total from 07-08...Melissa Anderson's 15 points in league play ranks ninth, along with three other WHEA skaters.

**University of Connecticut:** Connecticut took a 3-1 decision at Maine in its first game of the weekend series. Although Maine struck first, three different goal scorers lifted the Huskies past the Black Bears, including Brittany Murphy tallying her fourth of the season and Nicole Tritter netting the gamewinner. Amy Hollstein, who would come up big on Saturday, added an empty-net goal with 59 seconds remaining for the final score. On Saturday, for the second-consecutive weekend, the Huskies went to a shootout against a Hockey East opponent. Maine answered each UConn goal to leave her game tied 2-2 after 60 minutes and the Black Bears maintained their drive, denying the Huskies a shot on goal in the five-minute overtime. Hollstein netted the lone shootout goal to secure the conference victory. With the win, the Huskies have extended their winning streak at Orono to nine games.

**University of Maine:** Vanessa Vani stands just three points shy of becoming just the third person in program history to reach 100 career points...Genevieve Turgeon needs just 14 more saves to break the Maine single-season record for saves with 907, a mark she set last year...Myriam Croussette has 15 points, the most by a freshman since Vani tallied 24 in 2005-06...The Black Bears will travel to Vermont next weekend to determine who will finish in seventh in Hockey East...Maine is witnessing a passing of the reigns as all Black Bear goals this weekend were scored by freshman, Croussette scored two and Ashley Norum netted the game-tying goal on Saturday.

**University of New Hampshire:** UNH has won at least a share of the Hockey East regular-season title for the sixth consecutive year; the Wildcats won the title outright in '04, '06, '07 and '08 and will again this season with one more point or by BC not winning both of its games...UNH's power play is 5-for-11 in the last three games...UNH is 11-0-3 at home this season and is unbeaten in its last 27 home games (23-0-4)...The Wildcats have outscored the opposition 48-19, including 19-3 in the second period, in 14 home games.

**Northeastern University:** Northeastern will make its first playoff appearance since the 2003-04 season, when the Huskies lost to New Hampshire in the Hockey East semifinals...Coach Dave Flint notched his 100th career coaching win Sunday's playoff-clinching win over Vermont. In five seasons, Flint is 100-32-5 (.748)...Coach Flint will be making his first career playoff appearance this year, as Saint Anselm, where he coached for the past four years, was not eligible for postseason play...Sophomore goalie Leah Sulyma has matched her career high for wins in a season (seven) while playing in only 16 games so far this season instead of 31 in 2007-08...Annie Hogan (Jr., F, Medford, Mass.) set a career single-game high for assists (two) and points (three) in Northeastern's playoff-clinching win over Vermont Sunday.

**Providence College:** Providence will finish off the season with a home-and-home series against No. 7 Boston College beginning at Schneider Arena on Friday at 4:00 p.m...PC will honor the six graduating seniors before the game...Providence has dropped three straight games for the first time since the opening three games of the season...The Friars are still in the running for the 2nd seed in the Hockey East Tournament with a sweep of BC this weekend...PC has never finished lower than fourth since the inception of Hockey East.

**University of Vermont:** Vermont split a pair of road games at Northeastern, winning 4-3 Saturday and falling 4-3 Sunday...Freshman forward Erin Barley-Maloney (Raleigh, N.C.) had four points on the weekend (0-4-4) and now leads the team with 21 points, a program Division I single season record...Sophomore defenseman Peggy Wakeham had a goal and four assists against the Huskies. She became the first Vermont defenseman to reach 20 points (5g,15a) in a single-season. In league games, Wakeham is now second in Hockey East with 11 power play points and her 14 points are third among defensemen...Vermont wraps up its 2008-09 season hosting Maine Saturday and Sunday...Four UVM seniors, Ashley Walenty, Jessica Murphy, Danielle Ramirez and Sarah Smiddy, will be honored prior to Sunday's contest.
